

TIDE Resident Archive Status

1 - There are mirrored resident archives at GSFC <http://tide.gsfc.nasa.gov/> and the NSSTC in Huntsville <http://satyr.msfc.nasa.gov/TIDE/>

2-4 - TIDE level-zero data and ancillary data are available at each site. They are accessible from the Download-Data webpage. The websites have been stable for a number of years. The archives are automatically updated with new data and plots daily.

5 – Need more information about Virtual Observatories in order to for them to access the TIDE data archives.

6 - The website has half-orbit and perigee spectrogram plots for the entire Polar Mission available for viewing from the Summary-Plot or Thumbnails webpages. All data processing and display options can be run interactively using the Custom-Plot or Data-Dump webpages.

7 - ASCII data downloads can be done from either the Data-Dump webpage or the Moments and Velocity Distribution options of the Custom-Plot webpage.

8 - In addition to the pwgdata and CDAWeb ftp sites, orbit and attitude data are available on the TIDE data archive that can be accessed from the Download-Data webpage.

9 - The Related-Sites webpage contains links to several sites including all other Polar instruments. It does not include descriptions of any of the sites.

10 - Detailed documentation still needs to be written.
