



a. **Form FGIS-960, Official Grain Weight Certificate** (Exhibit B). The Form FGIS-960 is a white, general purpose official grain weight certificate with four carbon copies. It may be used for all inbound, outbound, local transfers, grain dust, grain screenings, and export lots of grain weighed under Class X requirements. Check off boxes have been provided for the type of movement section, type of carrier section, and kind of grain section to speed up the preparation process.

This certificate may also be used when combining lots (e.g., certification of several barges on one certificate or certification of a unit train on one certificate). Refer to section 2.4. For mandatory statements required by the regulations, see Table 1, page 2-26.

Form FGIS-960-L, Official Grain Weight Certificate (Exhibit C). The Form b. FGIS-960-L is a computerized weight certificate designed for printing certificates on perforated laser printer paper. Use the certificate for the same purposes as the Form FGIS-960. The certificate-printing program also allows printing information on the back of the certificate. The program prints two certificates per sheet and divides into two along the paper's micro-perforation. Each GIPSA field office has an assigned alpha character preceding the number of the certificate. The program assigns this number sequentially. Once the program has issued a certificate number, the program does not allow duplicates of the numbers, only voiding of the certificate. The program allows issuance of a duplicate numbered certificate only when clearly marked as "corrected" or "duplicate" (see Section 2.4). The computer program has a self-contained archiving and accountability routine and allows the printing of an accountability log on demand. The certificate program also allows selection of metric tons or pounds so that the correct measuring unit shows on the certificate template. The Form FGIS-960-10 is a continuous run NCR paper certificate with four copies using accordion folded paper, with perforated tear strips on either side of the certificate. GIPSA provides these certificates to elevators with automated weighing systems having tractor fed impact printers for weighing and certifying barge shipments. The certificates self-feed through the printers, decreasing the time official personnel have to monitor the printers. For mandatory statements required by the regulations, see Table 1, page 2-26.

e. **Form FGIS-964, Supervision of Grain Weight Certificate** (Exhibit G). The Supervision of Grain Weight Certificate (Form FGIS-964) is a yellow certificate, used for certifying all movements covered under an applicant's request for Class Y weighing service. The facility authorized to weigh keeps the original scale tape or scale tickets for all Class Y weighing completed. The supervising field office or official may request that facilities surrender all tapes and file copies of issued certificates for filing. Elevator weighers issue a Supervision of Grain Weight Certificate (Form FGIS-964) for <u>each</u> carrier weighed under the agreement with the supervising agency. See the Class Y section of Chapter 1, section 1.6 of the Weighing Handbook for procedures. Overprint the words CLASS Y WEIGHING on all parts in 30 percent solid black type with 133 line screen.


g. **Form FGIS-993, Commodity Inspection (& Weighing) Certificate** (Exhibit I). Use this certificate when bulk weighing export commodities covered by the Agricultural Marketing Act. As this is a multi-purpose certificate, type the title "Commodity Weight Certificate" in the space provided below "Commodity Inspection Certificate." Form FGIS-993 may also be used for domestic certification for bulk weighing or checkweighing. See Chapter 6 of the Processed Commodities Handbook for additional procedures for certifying checkweighing results on this certificate.

- Enter the title, "COMMODITY WEIGHT CERTIFICATE, BEAN WEIGHT CERTIFICATE, OR RICE WEIGHT CERTIFICATE." On the GIPSA certificate-printing package, use the subtitle field to enter this data.
- Enter the date the certificate is issued.
- Enter the name of the city and state of the field office or cooperator's office issuing the certificate.
- (4) Leave blank.
- (5) Enter the applicant's name, city, and state.
- Enter the location where the product was inspected (e.g., plant name, city, and state) or "Same" as in 5.
- (7) Enter the identification of the carrier and type of commodity.
- Enter the type of carrier (vessel, barge, boxcar, hopper car, container, or truck) and the net weight of the carrier. Use the same unit of mass (i.e., pounds or kilograms) that was used to calibrate the scale equipment.
- Enter under the heading "Remarks" the type of movement (Export/In/Out) and stowage (as applicable). These are minimum requirements. Other information may be supplied as requested.
- Upon request, show times started and finished, and gross, tare, and net weights. This information may be stamped directly on the certificate by

the scale or typed in later. When the official results are complete, enter in the remarks, "END OF RESULTS."

Enter the name or signature (or both) of the person who issued the certificate and, if affixed by an authorized agent, the word "By" and the agent's initials.

- h. **Form FGIS-993, Official Commodity Inspection (& Weighing) Certificate (Divided-Lot) (Exhibit I)**. This is the same form as Form FGIS-993, except staff enters the title, "DIVIDED COMMODITY WEIGHT CERTIFICATE on the GIPSA certificate-printing package, by using the subtitle field to enter the heading.
 - (1) Commodities offered for weighing and certified as a single lot may be divided into two or more weight certificates using Form FGIS-993, Commodity Inspection Certificate. The applicant may have as many divided certificates (Form FGIS-993's) as necessary, provided the total net weight for the Form FGIS-993's equals the total net weight shown on the surrendered original Form FGIS-993's issued as a single lot.

(2) Applicant Requirements

The applicant may exchange the certificate for two or more divided-lot certificates provided that:

- (a) The request is in writing;
- (b) The applicant is the one who requested the original weighing;
- (c) The request is made to the cooperator or the field office that issued the outstanding certificate;
- (d) The request is made within 5 business days of the outstanding certificate's date;
- (e) The request is made before the lot's identity is lost;
- (f) The cooperator or the field office has custody of the original weighing certificate (original and all copies); and
- (g) The request provides the name and complete address of each consignee and the quantity to be shown on each divided-lot certificate.

(3) Issuing Office Requirements

Show the following information on all official divided commodity weight certificates:

- (a) Identical information that was shown on the official commodity weight certificate, except show the net divided weights as the applicant requested.
- (b) The same statements that were on the original certificate.
- (c) The same serial number as shown on the superseded certificate, except that each divided-lot certificate has added a serially numbered suffix, e.g., 1764-1, 1764-2, 1764-3, etc.

Show on the original official commodity weight certificate, "Void-Surrendered for divided-lot certificates (Number) thru (Number)."
