A. BCC agrees to:

- 1. Provide a twenty-four hour per air day, dedicated channel (20) for RBS100 sole use for the transmission of it's programming to all BCC subscribers.
- 2. Provide a listing in it's written and on air programming guide of scheduled RBS100 programming when provided at least five working days prior to BCC publication of guides. Any actual additional cost incurred by BCC will be reimbursed by RBS100.

- 3. Provide, during normal BCC operating hours, access to RBS100 equipment housed in BCC facilities, for maintenance and operation of said equipment in the airing of programming.
- 4. Provide adequate security of RBS100 housed equipment and resources.
- 5. Provide the same support and transmission quality provided BCC primary channels.
- 6. Direct all parties requesting program airing to RBS100 for possible inclusion in RBS100 program schedule.

B. RBS100 agrees to:

- 1. Indemnify and hold harmless BCC, against liability claims resulting from content of RBS100 aired programming. RBS 100 is responsible for all content of it's originated programming and that aired by third parties by RBS100 on leased channel.
- 2. Provide resources required for operation of the dedicated channel to include the update of programming at the BCC facility.
- 3. Provide for, at the request of BCC, screening and airing of third party request for program airing. Airing on RBS channel is dependent on availability and content at the sole discretion of RBS100.
- 4. Provide only programming that meets the requirements of this agreement.

C. AGREEMENT PERIOD OF LEASE:

For consideration provided in Section VII of this agreement, RBS100 is provided an initial lease for the period <u>1 Devember 2007 through 30 November 2009</u>. In addition RBS100 is granted an option to renew, for the percentage agreed to in this agreement, for a period of three (3) additional years, based on written notification of intent to renew being received by BCC at least 2 months prior to the expiration of the initial lease period.
