- > 1996: Joined APEC
- > 1997: First U.S. Trade Mission
- > 2001: Bilateral Trade Agreement
- > 2003: Civil Aviation Agreement Signed
- 2006: Permanent Normalized Trading Relations
- > 2007: WTO Member; US-VN TIFA
