Job opportunities at the local and national level exist for creative and innovative professionals. VA is committed to developing a quality workforce to support its mission to provide the best possible care for our nation's veterans. In recognition of the contributions made by HIM professionals in helping achieve this goal, VA offers tangible and intangible benefits. VA provides a supportive environment that encourages professional growth and development and offers individual recognition for personal achievement.

In addition to professional opportunities, VA offers extensive employment benefits and educational opportunities that include generous leave accrual policies, mobility and educational assistance programs.

EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS for Health Information Management Professionals

HEALTH AND LIFE INSURANCE

- VA offers a variety of group health insurance plans with premiums partially paid by the Federal Government. You can change plans yearly.
- Term life insurance coverage based on salary is available with the cost shared by the Federal Government. Family and additional coverage options are available.

DID YOU KNOW THAT:

- VA employs more than 300 credentialed health information management professionals.
 VA fosters a stimulating work environment that promotes networking opportunities.
- VA supports a mentoring program to smooth the transition of newly appointed
 Chiefs of Health Information Management.
- VA provides clinical education for about 100,000 health professionals each year through affiliations with colleges and universities.
- VA is partnering with the Department of Defense and Indian Health Service to develop the Government Computerized Patient Record (GCPR) - middleware that shares patient records.
- VA's Computerized Patient Record System (CPRS) is state of the art with features that include:

All VA Medical Centers are JCAHO accredited.



LEAVE AND HOLIDAYS

- Thirteen to 26 days of paid annual (vacation/personal)
 leave are allocated per year. Annual leave begins to accrue
 immediately and can be used as it is earned subject to
 supervisory approval.
- 13 days of sick leave each year with no limit on accumulation.
- Military leave is authorized up to 15 days per year for active reservists and National Guard members.
- · VA observes 10 federal legal holidays.
- Family leave up to 12 workweeks of unpaid leave during any 12-month period for:
 - the birth of a child
 - the placement of a child for adoption or foster care
 - the care of spouse, son, daughter or parent with a serious health condition; or
 - a serious health condition.

RETIREMENT

Newly hired health information management professionals are covered by the Federal Employee's Retirement System (FERS). FERS is a three-tier retirement plan composed of Social Security benefits, FERS basic benefits, and the Thrift Savings Plan that is a tax deferred savings plan with an automatic basic contribution and partial matching by the Federal Government.

MOBILITY

VA medical facilities are located in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the Philippines. An employee may transfer to any location where there is a vacancy without loss of benefits and usually no loss in pay.

AWARDS, HONORS AND RECOGNITION

VA affords employees opportunities to participate in high profile projects that have significant impact and visibility at both the local and national level. Opportunities to receive both monetary and honorary recognition for overall superior performance and special or unique achievements are also available. In addition, substantial monetary awards can be earned through participation in VA's Employee Suggestion Program when employees offer creative solutions to problems and ideas for improving procedures and services.

Educational Opportunities

VA recognizes the importance of ongoing education and the benefit it provides to the veteran, patients and employees.

Numerous opportunities are available to health information management professionals, including:

- Tuition support for job-related and continuing education courses
- Health information management affiliated educational programs at many facilities
- National and regional education programs developed for health information management professionals
- Paid time off for approved continuing education programs
- Upward mobility programs



Personnel Policies

OUALIFICATIONS

Minimum qualifications for appointment as a VA health information management professional are:

- U.S. citizenship
- Specialized experience or successful completion of an accredited course of study. A current health information management credential from the American Health Information Management Association will be helpful as a measure of the health information management professional's quality of experience.

SALARY INFORMATION

- Starting salaries and grades are determined by the duties of the position to be filled and the nature and extent of professional education, training and experience.
- Special beginning rates or special salary rate ranges may be in effect at some locations based on pay-related staffing needs.
- Health information management professionals are awarded regular increases within each grade based on demonstrated performance and may receive accelerated increases for outstanding performance and achievement.
- Health information management professionals receive consideration for promotion to higher grades with correspondingly higher salaries.
- VA offers premium pay if health information management professionals are asked to work overtime, holidays, evenings, nights or outside of the established work schedule.
- Relocation expenses can be paid in some instances.
- Recruitment bonus is available.
