EXPEDITED STORM WATER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Thompson, Dreessen and Dorner, Inc., (herein the "Respondent") is a "person," within the meaning of § 502(5). of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1362(5), and 40 C.F.R. § 122.2.

Attached is a "Findings and Alleged Violations Form" (herein the "Form"), which is hereby incorporated by reference. By its signature, Complainant ("EPA") finds that However, EPA does not waive its rights to take any Respondent has committed the violation(s) set forth in the Form.

Respondent had an unauthorized discharge of storm water in violation of Section 301(a) of the Clean Water Act ("the Act" or "CWA"), 33 U.S.C. § 1311, and/or failed to comply with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") storm water permit authorized under attached Form.

EPA finds, and Respondent admits, that Respondent is subject to Section 301(a) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1311, and that EPA has jurisdiction over the allegations and any "person" who "discharges pollutants" from a "point source" to "waters of the United States". Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegation(s) specified in the Form.

EPA is authorized to enter into this Consent the violation(s) identified in the Form. Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO") under the authority vested in the Administrator of EPA by Section 309(g)(2)(A) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(g)(2)(A), and by 40 CFR APPROVED BY EPA: § 22.13(b). The parties enter into this CAFO in order to settle the civil violation(s) specified in the Form for a penalty of \$6,200.00. Respondent consents to the assessment of this penalty, and waives the right to contest the allegation(s) Leo & Alderman specified in the Form, and waives the right to appeal.

Additionally, Respondent certifies, subject to civiland criminal penalties for making a false statement to the United States Government, that it has corrected any deficiencies identified in the Form, and to the best of its knowledge, is in compliance with the NPDES permitting program.
