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## GENERAL INFORMATION

**CONDUCT:** All participants/staff are responsible for behaving in a manner reflecting credit upon themselves and the Civil Air Patrol. Misconduct may subject a participant/staff to dismissal from the activity.

**EQUIPMENT:** Teams should bring all required equipment to perform in the competition as stated in the competition guidelines.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: All participants/staff must be registered and present membership cards and two (2) CAPF 60's on reporting. If a membership card is not available, the participant/staff must have a copy of his/her listing on the current OHWG MML, downloaded via CAPWATCH that day. Senior Members and Cadets over 18 must have also completed Cadet Protection Policy Training.

REGISTRATION: Teams must register NLT COB 1 Feb 2006 by completing the application and sending it to Project Officer via email. Units sending observers should notify the Project Officer of expected numbers NLT COB 1 Mar 2006. Fee: All participants will pay \$7 to cover lunch and administrative costs. All observers are on their own for lunch, but have the option of paying \$7 for lunch. Activity fees must be paid by 1 Mar 2006, however, arrangements can be made if needed. There is no fee for staff/judges.

**SPENDING MONEY:** Participants/Staff will be "on their own" for breakfast and dinner; lunch will be provided. There will be no other opportunities to spend money at this activity.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation to and from the activity is a unit/individual responsibility.

**UNIFORM**: Each team and staff member will be given a schedule of events at the time of check-in. This schedule of events will be used to determine what uniform will be worn by participants/staff during the event. All other participants will wear the short-sleeve blue shirt combination or appropriate alternate uniform with proper weather clothing.

**COMPETITION GUIDELINES:** Teams will be judged in accordance with National Cadet Competition Rules of Engagement #5.3, dated 1 Feb 05 augmented by the OHWG Cadet Competition Guide.
