# Valve Box: 485W4068, structure CC (NW/NE/SW/NE Section 28, T21N, R102W 12/667800E/4625760N).

Structure CC is a valve box. The valve box is located on the top of a broad flat west to east trending ridge which serves as the south edge of Horse Thief Draw. The valve box is located approximately 7/8 mile northwest of Superior.

The valve box is a wood lined pit which is square in shape. The pit is 2 feet 11 inches north to south by 3 feet 0 inches east to west and 3 feet 2 inches deep to fill. The wood lining consists of vertically set milled lumber boards and quarter round secured by a frame of horizontal boards fastened to the interior surfaces of the box at its top. The valve box is partially filled with sediment covering the valve and pipe.
