

FAQ: Getting to the SCCTP Train the Trainer Workshop

How do I get to Cal State Fullerton (CSUF) from the Anaheim area?

The three most likely options are: car, taxi or public transportation (see below for more details on each).

Where exactly on the CSUF campus is the workshop located?

The workshop will be located in the Pollak Library South, Room L-360 (Oral History Conference Room). The Pollak Library is located in the center of campus. Follow this link for maps of the campus: <http://parking.fullerton.edu/Maps/>. (The Library is labeled "PL" on the map.)

How do I get there by car?

For customized driving directions from any address *other* than the Anaheim Convention Center, follow this link: <http://www.fullerton.edu/campusmap/> and supply the address of your starting location. These directions will take you right to the campus Parking Information Center, which is next to the Nutwood Parking Structure (NPS on map).

Freeway Route From the Anaheim Convention Center:

- Go east on Katella toward Hotel Way (2+ miles)
- Merge onto CA-57 north toward Pomona (5 miles)
- Exit Nutwood Ave., Exit 7; turn left at end of offramp (.5 mile)
- Turn right onto State College Blvd. (.1 mile)
- Turn right at Arts Drive (.1 mile)

Non-Freeway Route From the Anaheim Convention Center:

- Go east on Katella (2- miles)
- Turn left onto State College Blvd. (5 miles)
- Turn right at Arts Drive (.1 mile)

(This may take a bit longer depending on time of day)

You can park in the Nutwood Parking Structure (NPS on the map) and use the self-serve machine to purchase parking. Parking is \$5.00 per day; please note the machine takes 1 and 5 dollar bills only. Next to the parking structure is the Parking Information Center (it's the big "i" icon right next to NPS).

How do I get there by taxi?

If you are staying at a hotel, the concierge should be able to arrange a taxi for you; be sure to check with them in advance in case there is a wait. A taxi ride from the convention hotels to Cal State Fullerton will take 15-20 minutes, and you should be prepared to pay about \$ 32.00 one way, before tip. Share a ride if you can! This rate is an estimate; again, be sure to check with the concierge at your hotel first. Follow this

How do I get there using public transportation? MetroLink or the bus?

MetroLink is not a good option because you have to go to Angel Stadium to catch the train that brings you to the Fullerton train station and not to the campus. You would have to take a city bus to the stadium and the campus.

The OCTA bus is the better option if you need public transportation. The OCTA site estimates the trip at 55 minutes. The fare is \$1.25 (exact change is required). Starting at the Convention Center, Stop #0267, take Route 050 East, then transfer to Route 057 North which drops you at the campus.

Walk down Katella Ave. to KATELLA-CONVENTION CENTER in ANAHEIM, stop #0267

At 7:15 AM, take Route 050 East. Exit bus on Katella Ave. at KATELLA-STATE COLLEGE in ANAHEIM, stop #0273 at 7:25 AM.

Walk down Katella Ave. to State College Blvd.(Anaheim) on the next street. Turn right and walk to stop (#0645). Wait for transfer.

Wait 3 minute(s).

At 7:30 AM, take Route 057 North. Exit bus at STATE COLLEGE-CAMPUS in FULLERTON, stop #1933 at 7:54 AM.

Walk down State College Blvd. (Fullerton) to CAL STATE FULLERTON.

Walk down State College Blvd (Fullerton) to STATE COLLEGE-DOROTHY in FULLERTON, stop #1944 (on the right)

At 4:04 PM, take Route 057 South. Exit bus at STATE COLLEGE-KATELLA in ANAHEIM, stop #0682 at 4:36 PM.

Walk down State College Blvd (Anaheim) to Katella Ave. on the next street. Turn right and walk to KATELLA-STATE COLLEGE in ANAHEIM, stop #0278 (on the left). Wait for transfer.

Wait 7 minute(s).

At 4:44 PM, take Route 050 West. Exit bus at KATELLA-CONVENTION CENTER in ANAHEIM, stop #0284 at 4:53 PM.

Walk to ANAHEIM CONVENTION CENTER.

Reminder: please be at your stop 5-10 minutes early.

All times are scheduled times only. Actual time may vary due to traffic, construction detours, weather, and other conditions.

Can we bring food into the classroom?

Yes, food and beverages are allowed. (Remember there will be coffee and pastries in the morning when you arrive.)

What are the restaurant dining options either on or near campus?

On campus: In the student center there is a Togo's, Roundtable Pizza Pronto and Juice It Up. Also, just about the same distance from the Library walking in the other direction is a Carl's Jr. (still on campus) as well as a take out sandwich shop in Langsdorf Hall. All have outdoor seating nearby.

Off campus: There are also some "regular" restaurants that are about a 10-12 minute walk (each way) from the library: Panera, Jalapeno Grill, Quiznos.
