Market Tone

Export prices for most grades of rice continued to increase significantly, due mainly to unexpected strong demand for white rice from China, following its shortage there. Also, domestic supply remained tight, as the supply of second crop will not come onto the market until the next few months. Some exporters did not quote prices, due to the current volatility in the market. However, it is expected that the situation will came back to normal soon.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. The authority to report fragrant rice exports was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers from the Board of Trade for non-fragrant and from the Office of Commodity Standards for fragrant rice when available, but the reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.

Unofficial exports (excluding fragrant rice) for Mar. 1-7, 2004 totaled 101,059 tons, down 41,919 tons from the previous week's total and down 25,118 tons from the four-week moving average of 126,177 tons. Exports during Jan. 1 – Mar. 7, 2004 totaled 996,426 tons, compared with 744,562 tons during the same period in 2003.

According to the Department of Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including fragrant rice) during Jan. 1- Mar. 1, 2004, amounted to 1,286,212 tons, up 13 percent from 1,134,598 tons in the previous year.
