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1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Interim Budget Con-3 trol and Enforcement Act of 2001".

4 SEC. 2. PURPOSE.

- 5 The purposes of this Act are to—
- 6 (1) revise the fiscal year 2002 discretionary
 7 spending limits to reflect the recent agreement be8 tween the President and the Congress;
- 9 (2) make conforming changes in the section
 10 302(a) allocation to the Committees on Appropria11 tions for fiscal year 2002; and

18 SEC. 101. AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 251.

(a) DISCRETIONARY SPENDING LIMITS FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2002.—Section 251(c)(6)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended
to read as follows:

9 When the President submits a budget of the United 10 States Government under section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, for fiscal year 2003, he shall submit 11 12 a report to the Congress that identifies all emergency-des-13 ignated funding (pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) or section 252(e) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Def-14 15 icit Control Act of 1985) in legislation enacted after September 11, 2001, and before such submission in response 16 17 to the events of September 11, 2001, that is of an ongoing 18 and recurring nature.

18	FISCAL YEAR 2002 BUDGET RESOLUTION.
19	(a) CONFORMING CHANGES.—The chairman of the
20	Committee on the Budget of the House of Representatives
21	and the chairman of the Committee on the Budget of the
22	Senate shall each make necessary conforming changes for
23	fiscal years 2003 through 2011 (as appropriate) in total
24	new budget authority, total budget outlays, the surplus or
25	deficit, public debt, debt held by the public, net interest



(900), and allowances (920), as set forth in the concurrent
 resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2002. Such
 changed levels shall be deemed to be levels set forth in
 the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year
 2002 for all purposes under titles III and IV of the Con gressional Budget Act of 1974.

7 (b) REVISED SECTION 302(a) ALLOCATIONS FOR
8 FISCAL YEAR 2002.—

9 (1) It is the intent of this subsection that the 10 section 302(a) allocations to the Committee on Ap-11 propriations of each House for fiscal year 2002 will 12 be increased to \$683,201,000,000 in new budget au-13 thority and \$702,806,000,000 in outlays.

14 (2) Upon the enactment of this Act, the chair-15 man of the Committee on the Budget of the House 16 of Representatives and the chairman of the Com-17 mittee on the Budget of the Senate shall each make 18 the appropriate adjustments in the section 302(a)19 allocations to the Committee on Appropriations of 20 its House, as initially made by the explanatory joint 21 statement of managers accompanying the conference 22 report on the concurrent resolution on the budget 23 for fiscal year 2002, to the extent necessary to carry 24 out revisions and changes made by section 201.



1 (c)PUBLICATION IN THE CONGRESSIONAL 2 **RECORD.**—The chairman of the Committee on the Budget 3 of the House of Representatives and the chairman of the 4 Committee on the Budget of the Senate shall each have 5 published in the Congressional Record the changes and re-6 visions made pursuant to subsections (a) and (b).
