# Report Highlights:

India's MY 2003 almond imports revised down to 24,590 metric tons (shelled basis) and walnut exports lowered to 15,350 metric tons (in-shell basis).

### **SECTION I - SUMMARY**

Based on the latest official trade figures from the Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics (DGCIS), Ministry of Commerce, the estimate for walnut exports for MY 2003 has been marginally lowered to 15,350 metric tons (in-shell basis). The estimate for MY 2003 almond imports has also been revised lower to 24,590 metric tons based on the official DGCIS figures and almond shipment estimates from the California Almond Board. Estimates for stocks have been revised to reflect these changes.
