New Skies Satellites B.V. (New Skies) has filed a petition for a declaratory ruling for market access to the United States to provide service to and from the NSS-9 satellite at the 177° W.L. orbital location using the extended C-band frequencies of 3625-3700 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 5850-5925 MHz (Earth-to-space). New Skies requests waivers of Sections 25.210(a)(1) and (3), and Section 25.211(a) of the Commission's rules.
