

Jacksonville vicinity. **KINGSLEY PLANTATION**, Northern tip of Fort George Island at Fort George Inlet, Early-19th C. Frame, clapboarding, stuccoed tabby foundation; 1-2 stories, H-shaped, hipped and gabled roof sections, widow's walk, wide front and rear porches set between 2 1-story perpendicular wings; connected by covered walkway to the tabby and frame, 2 1/2-story gabled Anna's house (1791); outbuildings include tabby barn, tabby ruins of 24 slave cabins, and a tabby house ruin. Property purchased (1817) by Zephaniah Kingsley successful planter and member of the legislative council of the territory of Florida. *State.*
