

New Orleans. **OLD URSULINE CONVENT**, 1114 Chartres St., 1748-1752. Brick, stuccoed; 2 1/2 stories, rectangular, hipped roof, gabled dormers, interior chimneys, pedimented entrance section, segmental arched windows, quoins; extensive remodeling. Colonial elements. City's only remaining public building during French regime; served as convent, boys' school, archbishopric, and seminary. *Private; not accessible to the public*: NHL; HABS; G.
