

Ms. Lorraine Anderson Arvada City Council

Lorraine Anderson has been a member of Arvada City Council since 1985, currently serving in her fifth term. She served as Mayor Pro Tem for 6 years, a member of the Planning Commission for 4 years, founding member of the Arvada Clean Air Advisory Committee, founding member of the Arvada Economic Development Corporation, and many other City roles.

She is Past President of the Colorado Municipal League (CML), a statewide organization of 264 municipalities. She has been a member of the CML Executive Board since 1991. She is a member of the National League of Cities, served as Chair of the Energy, Environment, and Natural Resources (EENR) Steering Committee. She served as Chair of the Clean Air Task Force in 2002 that developed NLC's policy on the the reauthorization of the Clean Air Act. She currently serves on the NLC Board of Directors.

She has been a member of the Board of Directors of the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG), the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), since 1991, currently serves on the Executive Board as past Chair. She was Chair of the Transportation Policy Committee for seven years, and is past Chair of the Metro Vision Policy Committee.

Ms. Anderson is the lead representative for the City of Arvada for the Rocky Flats Coalition of Local Governments and is past Chair of the organization. She is a member of the Rocky Flats Stewardship Task Force Steering Committee. She is an active member of the Board of Directors of the Energy Communities Alliance and serves as Vice-Chair of that group.

Ms. Anderson has a BS degree in Business Administration from Regis University. She is retired as co-owner of Anderson Tire Service, Inc. She served as President of the Mountain States Tire Dealers Association in 1988, one of two women first elected to the Board of Directors and the first woman to serve as President.
