

Mason's Springs. **ARABY**, SE of Mason's Springs off MD 225, 18th-19th C. Brick (Flemish and English bond), 2 1/2-story main block connected to 1 1/2-story wing by later frame hyphen, gabled roof, joined pair of interior end chimneys, center entrance; original 1-story structure altered mid-19th C. by the addition of 1 1/2 stories, the replacement of the gambrel roof, and bridging of the chimneys; nearby gristmill ruins. Simple but elegant vernacular domestic architecture. Reputedly the home of George and Anne Eilbeck Mason until completion of their home Gunston Hall (see also Gunston Hall, VA). *Private, not accessible to the public.*
