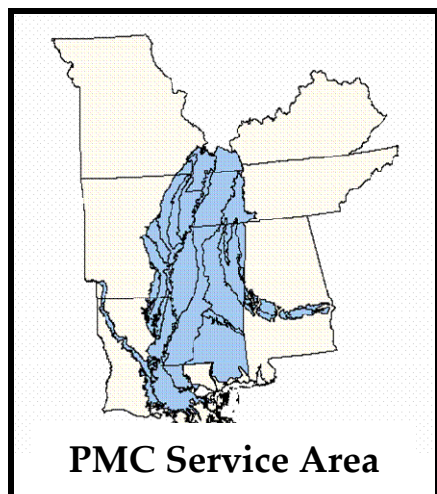


Seed & Plant Vendors of Conservation Plants for the Mid & Southeast U.S.

Introduction

This directory is a revision of the November, 2002 *Seed & Plant Vendors of Conservation Plants*, that was developed by the Jamie L. Whitten Plant Materials Center to assist conservationist in locating seed and plant vendors that supply native and non-native plant materials for our service area (**see map below**). The conservation plants and their varieties were selected by NRCS employees and cooperating agencies to reach land management goals that restore wildlife habitat, soil erosion, and disturbed ecosystems.
