Grindstone City. **GRINDSTONE CITY HISTORIC DISTRICT,** On U.S. 25, 19th-20th C. Area encompassing former site of one of major grindstone manufacturing centers in U.S.; includes 2 buildings, both of rock-faced stone, 2 and 3 stories, one with bracketed cornice and quoins the other with parapet around roof; remains of quarries and numerous grindstone pieces and slabs scattered on site. Grindstone manufacturing center once employed 200 persons and exported grindstones around the world declined with introduction of new sharpening materials and with the Depression. *Multiple public/private*.
