### **Design and Construct Diablo Lake Overlook Interpretive Shelter**

**Summary:** The Diablo Lake Overlook is the most popular location within the park complex, receiving an estimated 100,000 annual visitors, which is twice the number that visit the park's main visitor center. This project will design and construct a low-profile, enclosed on two sides, structure that will provide shelter from the sun and wind for park interpreters, a gathering point for visitors, and interpretive exhibits.
