| Moratorium Name | Date Imposed | Scope |
|---------------------------------------|---------------------|--|
| Weapons Program Records | -- | Covers records created and maintained by Weapons Program facilities. This moratorium has been lifted at several DOE facilities as the result of development of a site implementation plan and the completion of training. |
| Epidemiological Investigations | -- | Covers activities of the Agency and its Field Organizations which could have had health implications for the employees of the DOE or the public. |
| Uranium Enrichment | -- | Covers records related to the pricing of enrichment services for commercial power plants and a special assessment for decontamination and decommissioning of DOE Uranium Enrichment Facilities. Moratorium applicable to NE, EM, MA, CR, IG, and OR Programs primarily. |
| Sandia Corporation | -- | Records pertaining to recovering the cost for the refurbishment of their Albuquerque Manufacturing Facility. |
| Hanford Site "Down Winder" Litigation | -- | Covers the scope of operations at the Hanford Site. |
| Indian Territorial | 1987/2005-6 | Covers records pertaining to the use of Native American land and structures by the Department. |
| Asbestos Use and Remediation | 1997 | Covers records identifying the use of asbestos in DOE facilities. |
| Tobacco Industry Litigation | 2/2000 | Covers the activities of the DOE in investigating the affects of tobacco on health. All DOE records frozen initially, until NARA notified of which records series are not involved. |
| Spent Fuel Storage | 2000 | Covers records pertaining to the delay in acceptance of spent nuclear fuel from commercial nuclear power plants and subsequent additional cost incurred for it's on site storage. |
| Paducah | 2002/3 | Involves the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant. |
| ENRON | 2002 | Covers materials of all kinds from 1999 to present. This includes documents, electronic records including e-mail messages, computer records and storage devices, notes drafts, working papers and memoranda whether in the possession of the Department or your personal possession. |
| Sylvania-Corning | 2003 | Records pertaining to Sylcor, Sylvania-Corning Nuclear Corporation, Sylvania Electric Products Incorporated, GT&E Sylvania Incorporated, GTE Sylvania Incorporated, GTE Operations Support Incorporated |
| Yucca Mountain | 2003 | Records pertaining to the licensing of Yucca Mountain. |
| Spartan Technology vs. Allied Signal | 2003/2004 | Records pertaining to the operations of the Kansas City weapons facility |
| SAIC | 2004-5 | Records pertaining to SAIC and Clearance or disposition of radioactive metal or materials; SAIC's contracts with BNFL concerning metal recycling; NRC Rulemaking on the Disposition or Clearance of Radioactive Materials; DOE's Recycle 2000 Program; the BNFL Contract at Oak Ridge; and the interagency cooperative effort among DOE, EPA and NRC to establish standards for the clearance/disposition of radioactive |

| Records Relate To Hurricane Katrina and Recovery | 10/05 | As identified by each site – Frozen by GC until further notice. |
| Viacom | 2005 | Records related to the Manhattan Project at the Bloomfield Facility for the time period 1941-1944. |
| SR Fatality (EH) | 2005 | Records pertaining to the fatality at the SRS on July 26, 2004. |
| Public Citizen v. Raines | 2005 | Records pertaining to “DOE’s Major Information Systems” |
| ALCOA/Reynolds | 2005 | Involves CERCLA contribution claims against several agencies and the United States. |
| AEC Contracts | 2005 | Involves contracts between AEC and MIT or one of its research divisions. |
| Arrow Electronics, Inc. | 2005 | Involves DOE sites that have done or do business with Wyle Laboratories either at the Alabama or the California location. |
| Public Citizen v. Bolten | 2005 | Records pertaining to “DOE’s Major Information Systems” |
| People Soft | 2006 | Records and communications related to transactions with PeopleSoft, including official records and nonrecord materials, and any electronic records and e-mails relating to these transactions. |
| Cheswick/NASA NERVA | 2005/2006 | Involves work on the Nuclear Engine for Rocket Vehicle. |
| Midnight Mining-Dawn Mining-Newmont Mining Corp. | 2005 | Involves Midnite uranium mine on the Spokane Indian Reservation, Stevens County, Washington |
| Iraq Oil- for-Food | 2006 | Involves records of activities of, or participation in, the Iraq Survey group. |
| Carbon Fiber-False Claims Act | 2006 | Involves records (especially invoices, cost-related documents, payment-related documents, contracts, etc.) showing DOE has purchased directly or indirectly (through prime contracts, subcontracts, purchase orders, or otherwise) a substance known as carbon fiber in any form; or purchased any products, equipment, etc., with carbon fiber comprising a substantial part of the product/equipment’s makeup (products using carbon fiber). |
