

Wailuku. **KAAHUMANU CHURCH**, S. High St., 1876 Stone, painted; 1 story, rectangular, steeply-pitched gable roof with returning cornice, tripartite steeple, double-door arched entrance, pointed-arched windows with some tracery, buttresses, quoins; steeple and tower added, 1884. Vernacular adaptation of Gothic Revival style with some Georgian elements. One of few extant native churches; associated with missionaries Edward Bailey and Jonathan Green. *Private*.
