

Washington. **WASHINGTON PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH**, 206 E. Robert Toombs Ave., 1825. Frame, clapboarding; 1 story, rectangular, gabled roof, 2-stage steeple with shingled conical roof, center double-door entrance with semielliptical fanlight and side lights, flanking round arched windows, elliptical window in shingled gable, portico with slender fluted columns; steeple and vestibule added 1836; porch added c. 1890; rear additions 1940. Federal elements. One of state's finest examples of a unpretentious New England type church; the church's first minister, John Springer, was also the first Presbyterian minister to be ordained in the state.
