 (\$25.00) includes all cadet activities during the day Saturday and the Dinner Banquet Saturday
 evening. Lunch will be available for a nominal fee at the Shaw Dining Hall.
- Conference only registration for Senior Members (\$10.00) includes all seminars, coffee breaks, and lunch during the day Saturday. Conference only registration for cadets (\$10.00) includes all cadet activities during the day Saturday.
- Cost for ONLY the Dinner Banquet Saturday evening is \$25.00 for all members and guests.
- Pre-registration deadline is 15 September (postmark date). After that date, registration fee and banquet tickets increase by \$10.00; no refunds will be given after that date.
- CAP members are asked to complete one registration form per person. Those bringing a civilian guest may complete one form for both. It is preferred that all squadrons write one check for their cadets who will be attending.

Room Reservations:

• No billeting is available on base. Because of the poor use of the conference hotels in the past, there are none this year. However, there are half a dozen hotels about 6 miles east of Shaw in the 2400-2500 blocks of Broad St. (Hwy 378) in Sumter. Most attendees in the past have gotten the same or better than the conference rate by using AAA or government rates.

Uniform:

- Conference: While USAF blues and either corporate uniform are the preferred dress at wing, region and national conference meetings and classes, the golf shirt uniform is acceptable. Flight suits are not acceptable. Cadets will wear BDU's, PT wear, or blues depending on their activities activities.
- Banquet: Male cadets must wear blues with white shirt and black bow tie or a suit and tie. Female cadets should wear a formal or semi-formal gown. For the banquet, semi-formal civilian dress, such as a suit and tie for men and dressy attire for women, is acceptable, although formal and mess dress is preferred. *Mess dress is not authorized for cadets.* Evening dress should be appropriate (no halter tops, skirts more than 2" above the knee, skin-tight clothing, etc.).
- Uniform wear in accordance with regulations will be strictly enforced. AF-style uniforms <u>will not</u> be worn if weight and grooming standards are not met.

Protocol:

• We are guests of the US Air Force and Shaw AFB. Proper protocol is expected and required from all participants. This includes being in proper uniform, being covered when outdoors, saluting senior officers when covered, and conducting oneself with the proper military demeanor. Any participant who engages in improper behavior may be asked to leave the conference. All members are required to show the respect dictated by the rank and position of any honored guests.
