COUNT 1

The Grand Jury charges:

Beginning at least as early as May, 2005, and continuing through June, 2006, the exact dates to the Grand Jury unknown, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, and

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elsewhere, MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, KENNETH AGEE, aka BHEAD, PERRY AUSTIN, aka TWIN, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, JAMES BRASWELL, aka JAY, aka TONE, HAROLD CAMERON, aka TY, TREVOR CAMPBELL, aka BLACK, CORDELL DANIELS, aka MC, KEVIN DANIELS, aka KILLER KEV, CHRISTOPHER ELLIOT, aka CANNON, aka CAN, BRANDON GEER, aka TYSON, TORRENCE GILLIS, aka TCHEESY, ABDUL GLOVER, aka ABDUL, RAYMOND HARRIS, aka HAZE, LAMONT HEARD, aka BIG HEARD, aka BILL, JEREMIAH JACKSON, aka MEYER LANSKY, aka EL, ANTHONY KARBAN, aka TONE, JEFFREY LEE, aka BIG JEFF, JERMAINE LEE, aka SMURF, aka J, MARCYL KELLY, MICHAEL MAY, aka DIESEL, aka D, LASHAWN MONCRIEF, aka SHAWN, LEONARD MONCRIEF, aka BOOMER, DARNELL NESBIT, aka DNASTY, aka D, KALEEF REED, aka KBURPO, aka KHALEEF REID, aka K, CHRISTOPHER WILEY, aka WILEY, aka PEE, ANTHONY WILSON, aka ANTHONY EVANS, aka PAULY, and OMAR WILSON, aka OMAR, aka O, the defendants herein, did unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate, and agree together and with each other, and with diverse others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to possess with the intent to distribute and to distribute 50 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

MANNER AND MEANS OF THE CONSPIRACY

A. It was part of the conspiracy that some conspiracy members would identify some members of the conspiracy as "Dirty

Thirties" and/or "D-30's". The "Dirty Thirties" ("D-30's") identified themselves by tattoos, graffiti, and hand signals.

B. It was part of the conspiracy that conspiracy members would purchase quantities of cocaine base ("crack") from MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, JERMAINE LEE, aka SMURF, aka J, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, and JAMES BRASWELL, aka JAY, aka TONE .

C. It was further part of the conspiracy that conspiracy members would sell quantities of cocaine base ("crack") to other members of the conspiracy, other drug dealers, and drug users, in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, located between East 22nd and East 30th Streets, Cleveland, Ohio.

D. It was further part of the conspiracy that conspiracy members would receive and pass messages (sometimes using pushto-talk phones) among each other to facilitate drug transactions.

E. It was further part of the conspiracy that conspiracy members would direct buyers to other members of the conspiracy to conduct the drug transactions requested by the buyer.

F. It was further part of the conspiracy that members of the conspiracy would provide each other with advice and protection from law enforcement surveillance and rival drug sellers.

G. It was further part of the conspiracy that conspiracy members would combine ("pool") their drugs to engage in drug sales of greater quantities.

H. It was further part of the conspiracy that juveniles were recruited by conspiracy members to assist conspiracy members in drug transactions.

I. It was further part of the conspiracy that conspiracy members engaged in violence and/or threats of violence to facilitate the goals of the conspiracy.

OVERT ACTS

In furtherance thereof, and to effect the objectives of the conspiracy, the defendants and others performed overt acts in the Northern District of Ohio, including but not limited to the following:

 On August 16, 2005, JERMAINE LEE, aka SMURF, aka J, and ABDUL GLOVER, aka ABDUL, sold 1.32 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a person cooperating with law enforcement (herein after "CW") in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

2. On August 17, 2005, TREVOR CAMPBELL, aka BLACK, sold 7.97 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

3. On August 19, 2005, CHRISTOPHER WILEY, aka WILEY, aka PEE, sold 2.79 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

4. On August 24, 2005, BRANDON GEER, aka TYSON, and MICHAEL MAY, aka DIESEL, aka D, sold 2.89 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

5. On August 30, 2005, ANTHONY WILSON, aka ANTHONY EVANS, aka PAULY, possessed a firearm in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

6. On October 11, 2005, MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, sold 6.70 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

7. On October 20, 2005, CHRISTOPHER ELLIOT, aka CANNON, aka CAN, sold 5.19 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

8. On October 21, 2005, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, and HAROLD CAMERON, aka TY, sold 9.16 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

9. On October 25, 2005, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, and HAROLD CAMERON, aka TY, sold 11.79 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

10. On October 26, 2005, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, sold 11.93 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

11. On October 31, 2005, CHRISTOPHER ELLIOT, aka CANNON, aka CAN, and ANTHONY KARBAN, aka TONE, sold 8.20 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

12. On November 3, 2005, ANTHONY KARBAN, aka TONE, sold 9.25 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

13. On November 7, 2005, CHRISTOPHER WILEY, aka WILEY, aka PEE, sold 12.10 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

14. On November 8, 2005, KALEEF REED, aka KBURPO, aka KHALEEF REID, aka K, and OMAR WILSON, aka OMAR, aka O, sold 2.62 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

15. On November 8, 2005, KALEEF REED, aka KBURPO, aka KHALEEF REID, aka K, and OMAR WILSON, aka OMAR, aka O, sold 3.96 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

16. On November 16, 2005, ABDUL GLOVER, aka ABDUL, sold 1.66 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

17. On November 23, 2005, KEVIN DANIELS, aka KILLER KEV, and ANTHONY WILSON, aka ANTHONY EVANS, aka PAULY, sold 10.17 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

18. On November 23, 2005, MARCYL KELLY permitted her residence, located at the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio, to be used to distribute cocaine base ("crack").

19. On November 29, 2005, ANTHONY WILSON, aka ANTHONY EVANS, aka PAULY, sold 22.19 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

20. On November 29, 2005, MARCYL KELLY permitted her residence, located at the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio, to be used to distribute cocaine base ("crack").

21. On November 30, 2005, JAMES BRASWELL, aka JAY, aka TONE, sold 1.49 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

22. On December 1, 2005, CORDALE DANIELS, aka MC, sold 1.01 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

23. On December 2, 2005, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, and CORDALE DANIELS, aka MC, sold 9.75 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

24. On December 13, 2005, JAMES BRASWELL, aka JAY, aka TONE, sold 12.74 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of 3333 Detroit Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio.

25. On December 13, 2005, KEVIN DANIELS, aka KILLER KEV, JEFFREY LEE, aka BIG JEFF, and JERMAINE LEE, aka SMURF, aka J, sold 6.80 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

26. On December 15, 2005, JEFFREY LEE, aka BIG JEFF, sold 9.49 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

27. On December 16, 2005, JEFFREY LEE, aka BIG JEFF, and JERMAINE LEE, aka SMURF, aka J, sold 12.42 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

28. On December 29, 2005, LAMONT HEARD, aka BIG HEARD, aka BILL, and CORDALE DANIELS, aka MC, sold 7.23 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

29. On January 5, 2006, MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, sold 32.87 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

30. On January 9, 2006, MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, sold 6.15 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

31. On January 25, 2006, LASHAWN MONCRIEF, aka SHAWN, possessed with the intent to distribute 2.87 grams of cocaine base ("crack").

32. On February 13, 2006, JEREMIAH JACKSON, aka MEYER LANSKY, aka EL, sold 0.48 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

33. On February 14, 2006, PERRY AUSTIN, aka TWIN, and RAYMOND HARRIS, aka HAZE, sold 0.63 grams of cocaine base

("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

34. On February 15, 2006, DARNELL NESBIT, aka DNASTY, aka D, sold 3.68 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

35. On February 23, 2006, JEREMIAH JACKSON, aka MEYER LANSKY, sold 2.76 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

36. On March 2, 2006, DARNELL NESBIT, aka DNASTY, aka D, sold 2.60 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

37. On March 2, 2006, KENNETH AGEE, aka BHEAD, MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, and LAMONT HEARD, aka BIG HEARD, aka BILL, sold 8.21 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

38. On March 15, 2006, RAYMOND HARRIS, aka HAZE, sold 3.10 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

39. On March 24, 2006, RAYMOND HARRIS, aka HAZE, sold 5.60 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

40. On March 27, 2006, JEREMIAH JACKSON, aka MEYER LANSKY, aka EL, sold 5.98 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

41. On April 11, 2006, KEVIN DANIELS, aka KILLER KEV, sold 0.65 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

42. On April 27, 2006, DARNELL NESBIT, aka DNASTY, aka D, sold 1.46 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

43. On May 5, 2006, LEONARD MONCRIEF, aka BOOMER, sold 1.14 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

44. On May 9, 2006, HAROLD CAMERON, and TY, and MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, sold 16.79 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

45. On May 9, 2006, TORRENCE GILLIS, aka TCHEESY, possessed with the intent to distribute approximately 4.12 grams of cocaine base ("crack") in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

46. On May 9, 2005, PERRY AUSTIN, aka TWIN, possessed with the intent to distribute approximately 2.28 grams of cocaine base ("crack") in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

47. On May 9, 2005, PERRY AUSTIN, aka TWIN, sold approximately 0.14 grams of cocaine base ("crack") to a CW in the vicinity of the Cedar Estates Housing Project, Cleveland, Ohio.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT 2

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about August 16, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, JERMAINE LEE, aka SMURF, aka J, and ABDUL GLOVER, aka ABDUL, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 1.32 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 3

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about August 17, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, TREVOR CAMPBELL, aka BLACK, and others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 7.97 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 4

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about August 19, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, CHRISTOPHER WILEY, aka WILEY, aka PEE,

and others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 2.79 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 5

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about August 24, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, BRANDON GEER, aka TYSON, and MICHAEL MAY, aka DIESEL, aka D, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 2.89 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 6

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about August 30, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, ANTHONY WILSON, aka ANTHONY EVANS, aka PAULY, did knowingly possess a firearm in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, to wit: conspiracy to possess with the intent to distribute and the distribution of cocaine base ("crack") as charged in Count 1 of this indictment, a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A); in violation of Title 18, Section 924(c), United States Code.

COUNT 7

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about October 11, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, MUHAMMED DYE, aka RED, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 6.70 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

COUNT 8

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about October 20, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, CHRISTOPHER ELLIOT, aka CANNON, aka CAN, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 5.19 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

COUNT 9

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about October 21, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, and HAROLD CAMERON, aka TY, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 9.16 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 10

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about October 25, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, and HAROLD CAMERON, aka TY, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 11.79 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 11

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about October 26, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, KEVIN BALLARD, aka KEV, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 11.93 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

COUNT 12

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about October 31, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, CHRISTOPHER ELLIOT, aka CANNON, aka CAN, and ANTHONY KARBAN, aka TONE, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 8.20 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 13

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about November 3, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, ANTHONY KARBAN, aka TONE, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 9.25 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

COUNT 14

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about November 7, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, CHRISTOPHER WILEY, aka WILEY, aka PEE, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 12.10 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

COUNT 15

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about November 8, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, KALEEF REED, aka KBURPO, aka KHALEEF REID, aka K, and OMAR WILSON, aka OMAR, aka O, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 2.62 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 16

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about November 8, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, OMAR WILSON, aka OMAR, aka O, and KALEEF REED, aka KBURPO, aka KHALEEF REID, aka K, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 3.96 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 17

The Grand Jury further charges:

On or about November 16, 2005, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, ABDUL GLOVER, aka ABDUL, did knowingly and intentionally distribute approximately 1.66 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack"), a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

COUNT 18

The Grand Jury further charges:
