JUDGMENT

GÓMEZ, C.J.

Before the Court are the motions of defendants Gelean Mark ("Mark"), Vernon Fagan ("Fagan"), Alan Dinzey ("Dinzey"), Keith Francois ("Francois"), Alexci Emmanuel ("Emmanuel"), Dave Blyden ("Blyden"), Tyrone Alexander Prince ("Prince"), Royd Thompson

("Thompson") and Leon Boodoo ("Boodoo") (the "defendants") for suppression of all communications intercepted by wiretap pursuant to Title III of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act, 18 U.S.C. §§ 1810 et. seq., ("Title III"). In addition, Francois has moved to suppress the statements he made to law enforcement officers after he was arrested. Fagan also seeks suppression of the drug ledgers and paraphernalia found during a search of his residence and crack cocaine uncovered during a search of his vehicle. For the reasons stated in the accompanying memorandum of even date, it is hereby

ORDERED that the motion of the defendants to suppress the communications intercepted through the Title III wiretaps is DENIED; it is further

ORDERED that Francois' motion to suppress the statements he made to law enforcement after his arrest is DENIED; it is further

ORDERED that Fagan's motion is **DENIED** to the extent it seeks suppression of the drug ledgers and paraphernalia found in his residence; it is further

ORDERED that Fagan's motion is GRANTED to the extent it seeks suppression of the crack cocaine uncovered after the illegal search of his vehicle; and it is further

ORDERED that the crack cocaine found in Fagan's vehicle shall be SUPPRESSED.
