

Boise. **IMMANUEL EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH**, 707 W. Fort St. 1908-1914, Charles F. Hummel I, architect. Rock-faced stone, frame, shingling; 1 1/2 stories, cross-shaped, gabled roof with small gabled projections, exterior chimney front center glazed double-door entrance in gabled portal with pointed-arched transom and surmounting tripartite window; front corner tower with louvered belfry, corner pinnacles, and steep dormered spire; interior alterations. Gothic Revival elements. Designed by Charles F. Hummel I, prominent local architect one of only two Gothic Revival churches remaining in Boise. *Private.*
