Rockland and vicinity. **ROCKLAND HISTORIC DISTRICT**, Town of Rockland and its environs along Rockland Rd. and Brandywine Creek, 18th-20th C. Rural milling district substantial stone buildings on banks of the Brandywine includes mostly 2-3-story stone dwellings with gabled roofs and interior end chimneys, also one remaining mill, ruins another mill, and the home (built 1802) of millowner William Young with its Georgian appearance. Mill-centered area once included grist, saw, fulling, and paper mills and employed many workers, some of whom dwelled in the plain stone houses, with millowners living in more attractive residences. *Multiple private*.
