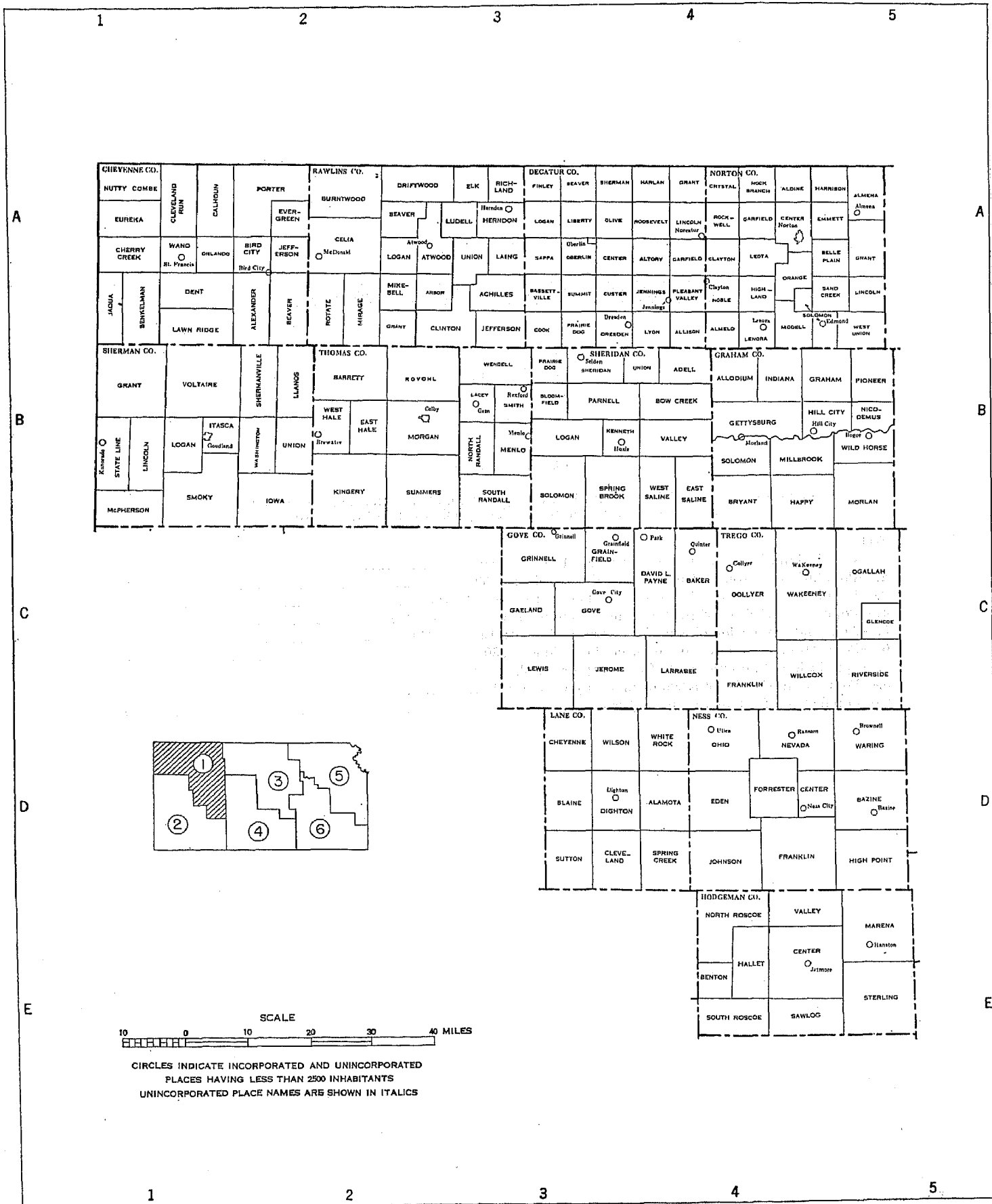

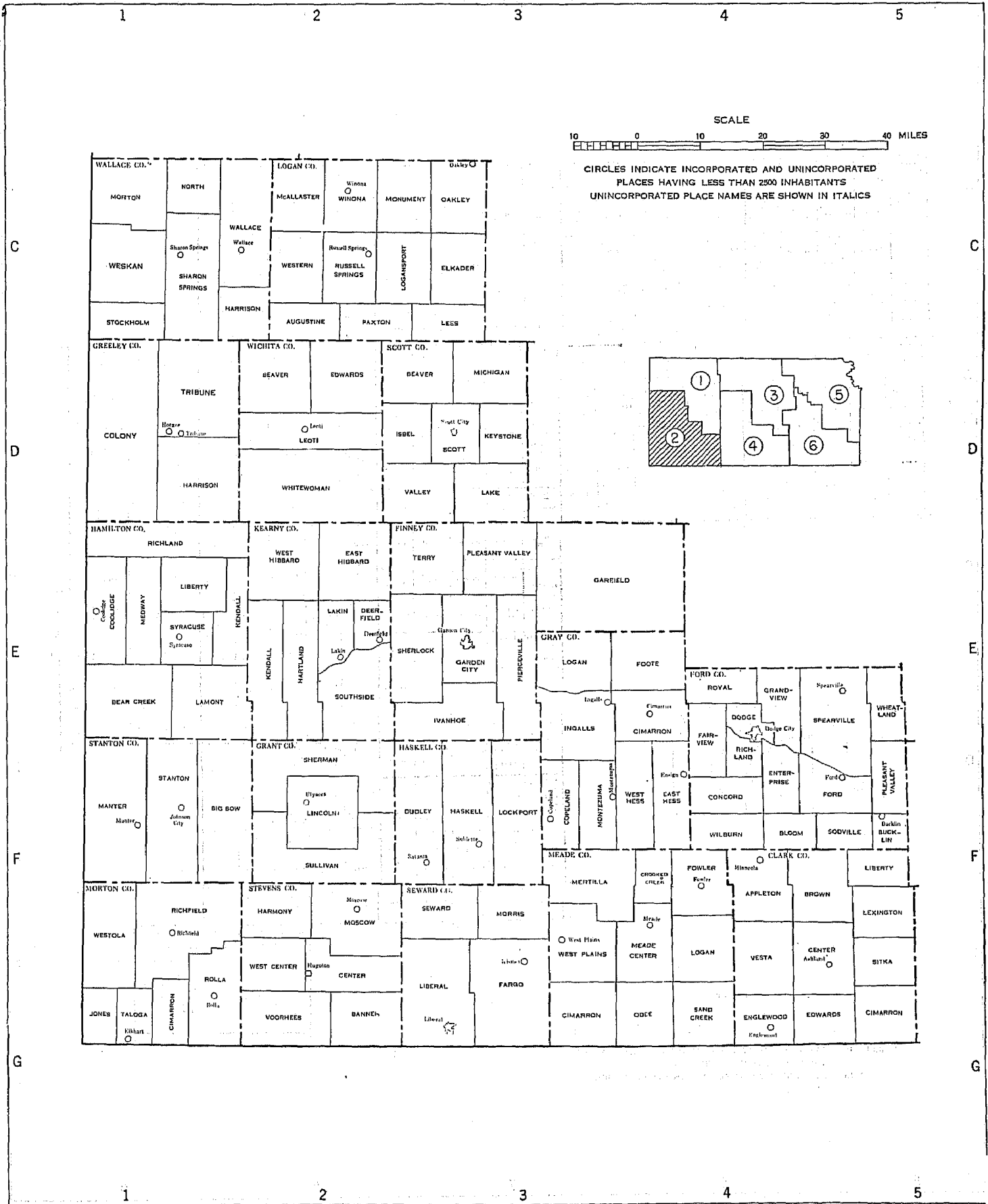

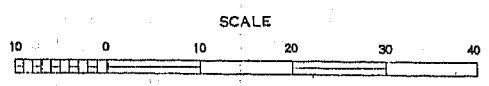
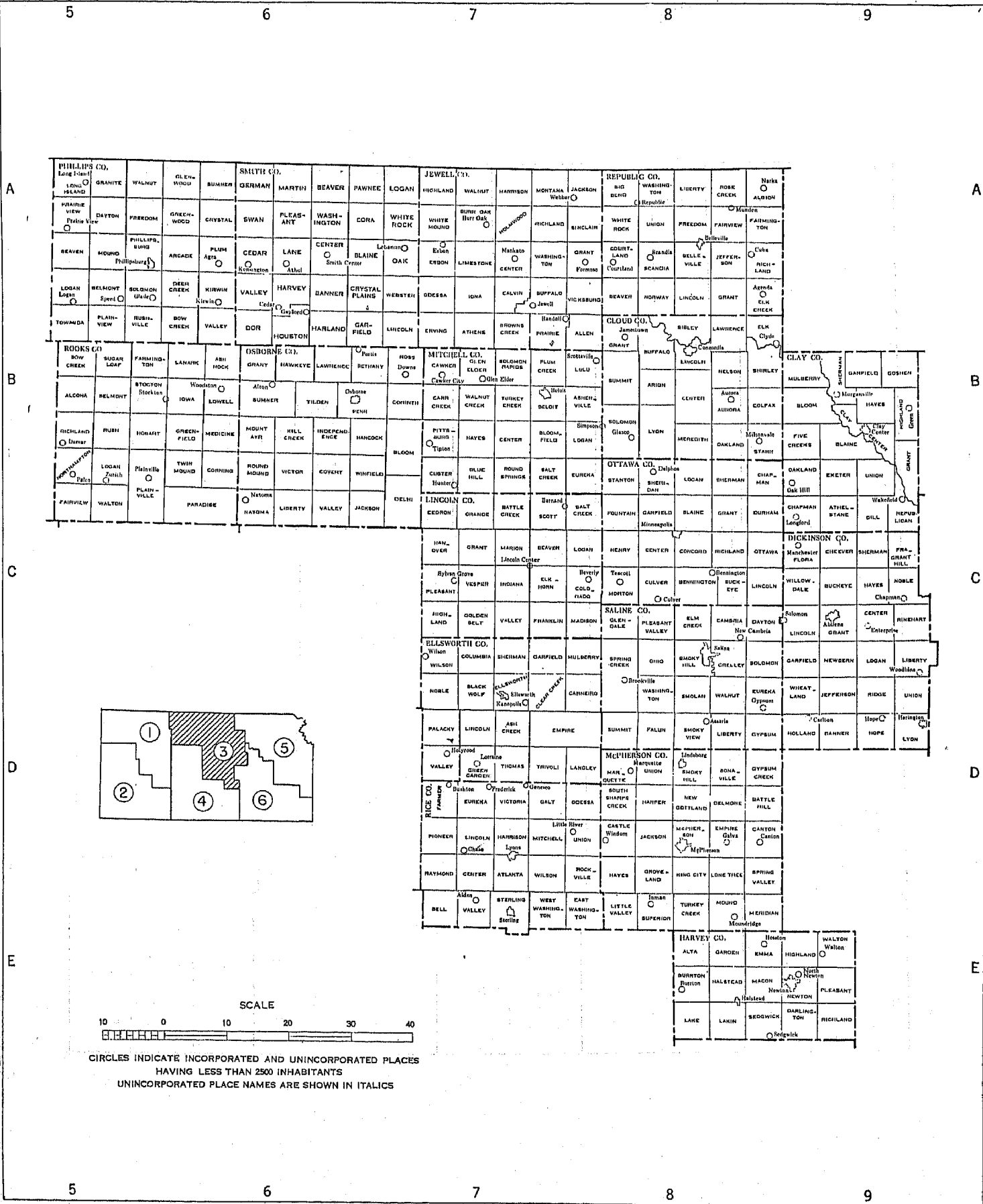


MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNSHIPS



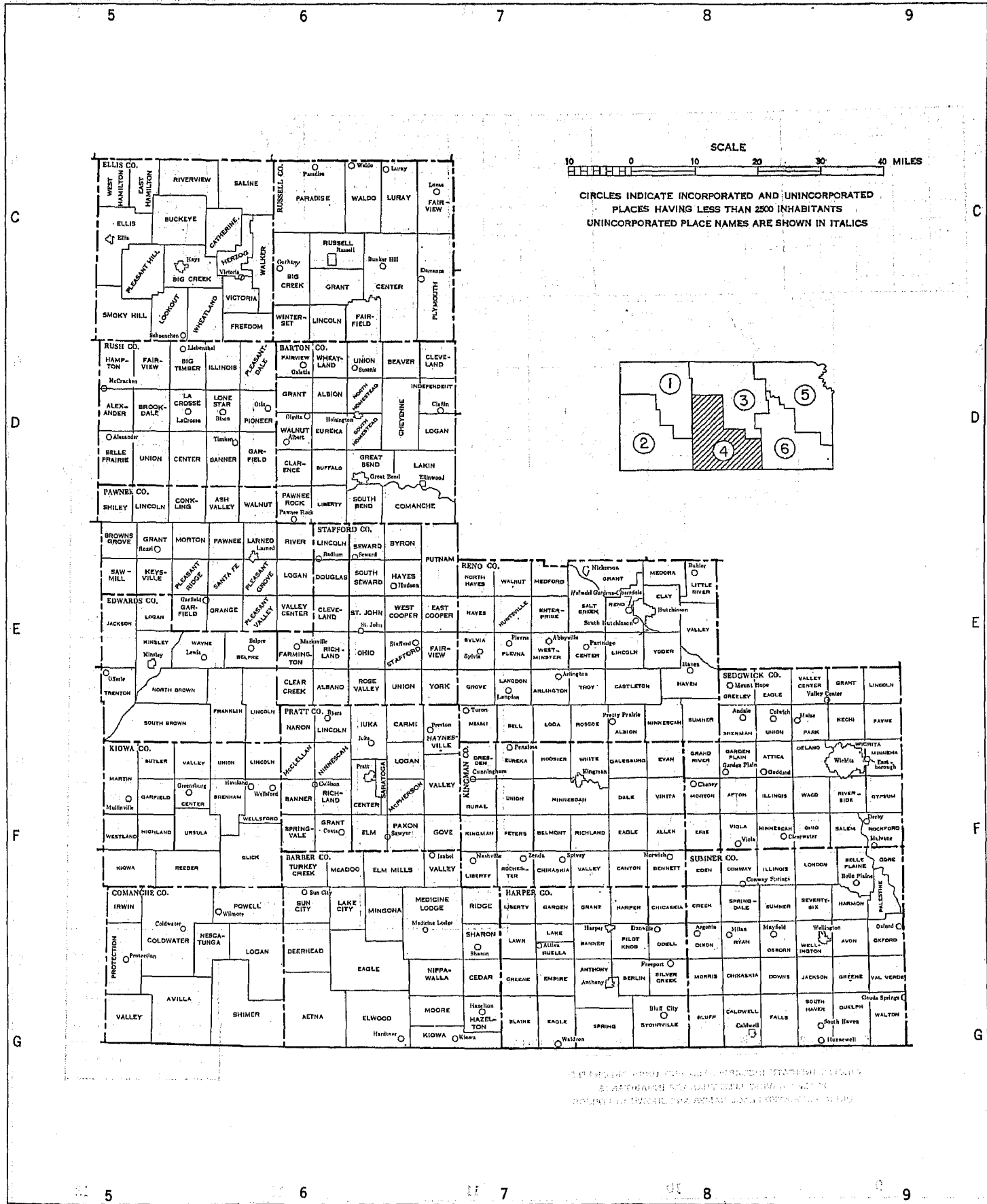
KANSAS—SECTION 3, NORTH CENTRAL PART

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNSHIPS



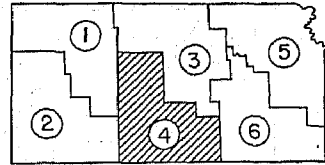

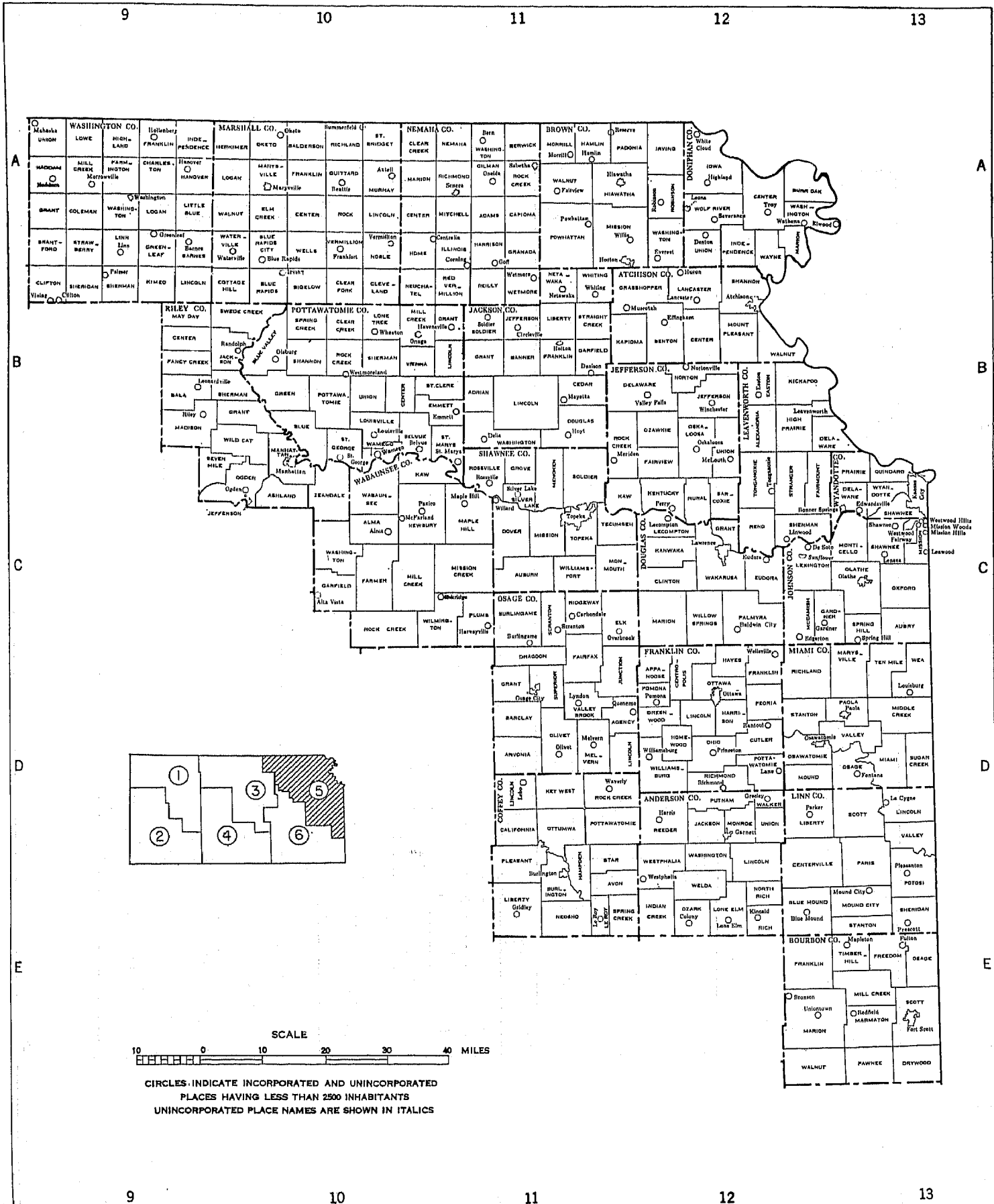

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNSHIPS

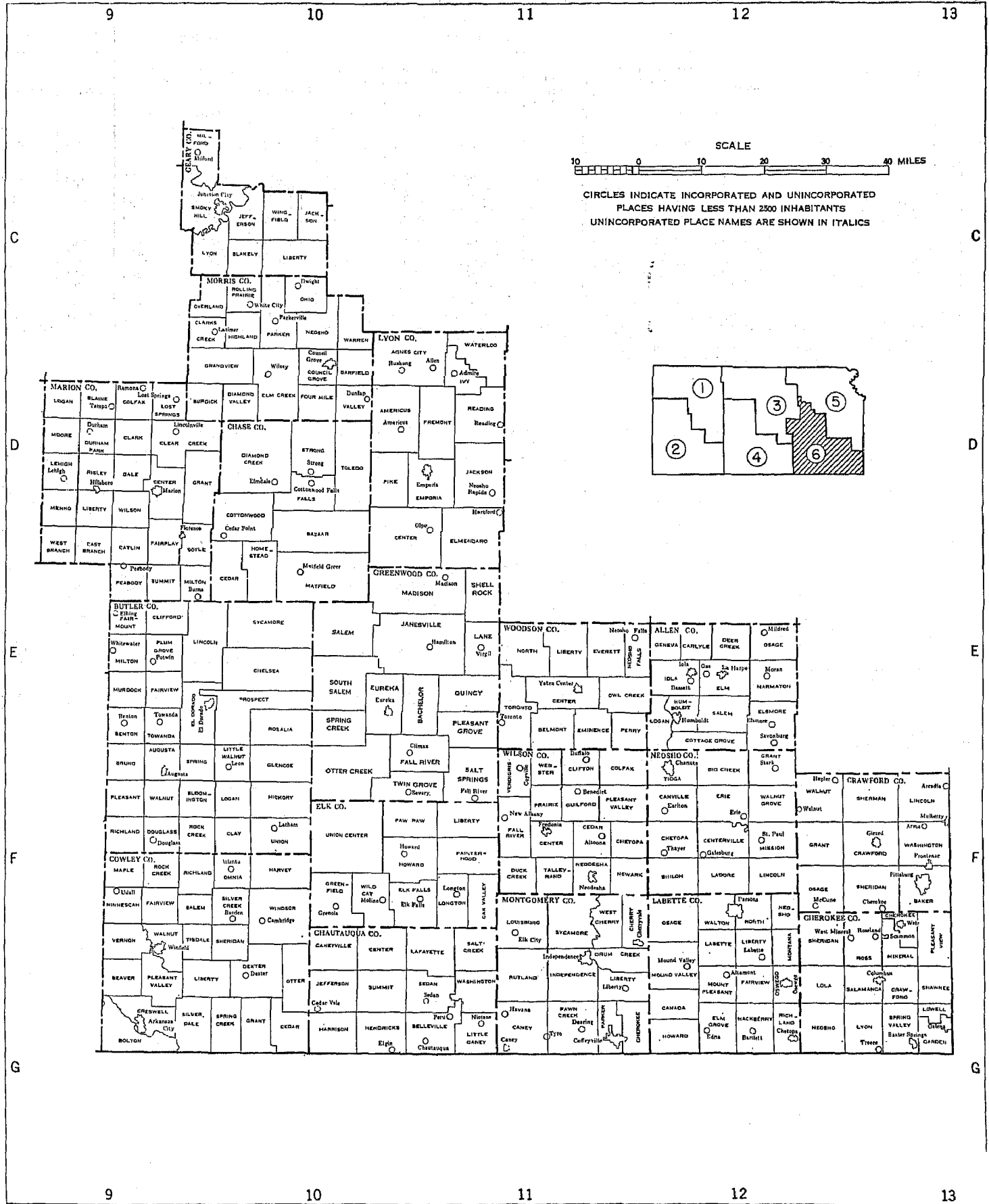

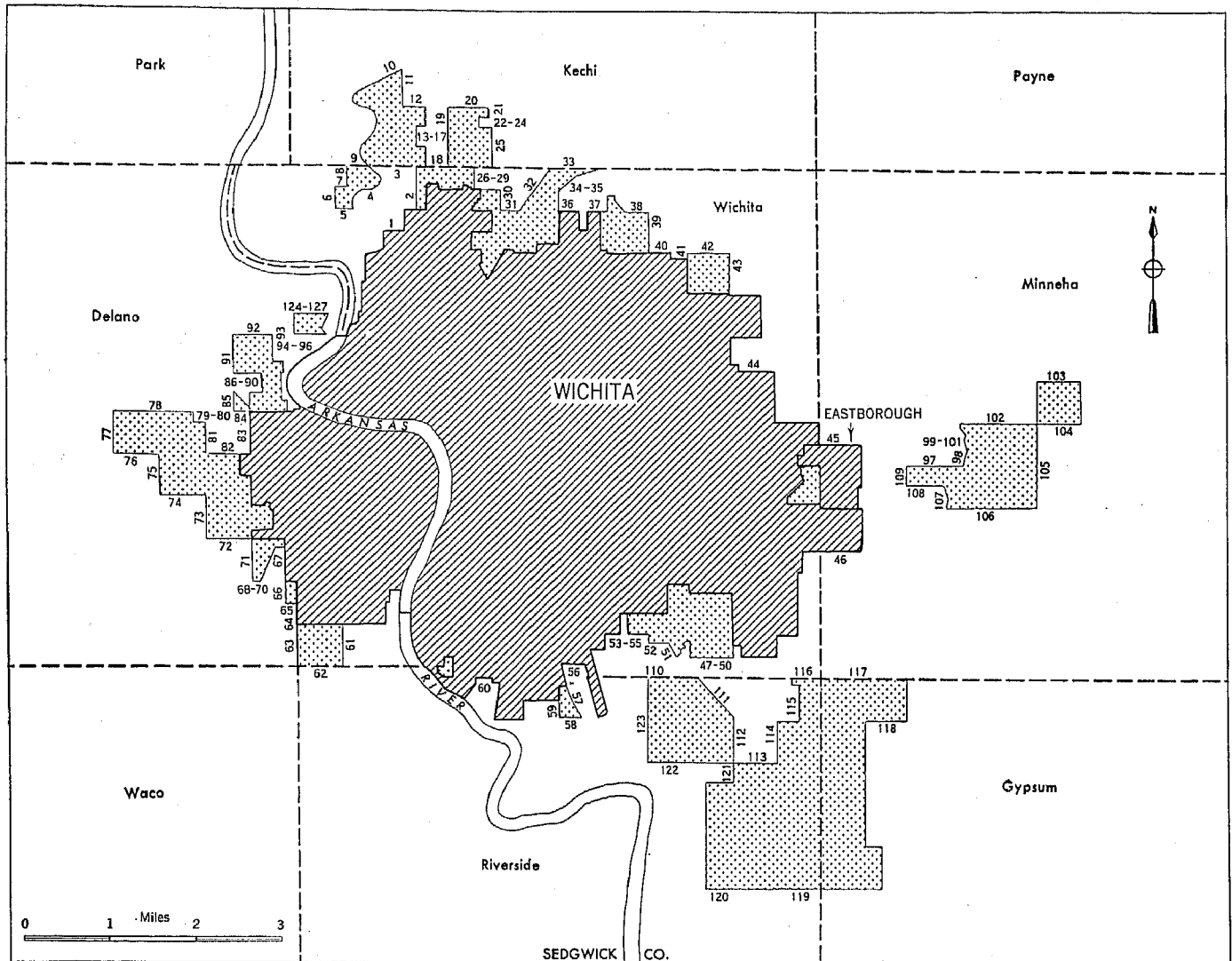
