This instruction provides information on the 1-year oncology demonstration project for calendar year 2006. This transmittal stated that the physician specialties that qualify under the 2006 oncology demonstration are: hematology (82), medical oncology (90), and hematology/oncology (83).

### B. Policy:

We inadvertently omitted the specialty of gynecological oncology (98) from the list of physician specialties participating in the 2006 oncology demonstration. By means of this transmittal, we are including the specialty of gynecological oncology (98) in this demonstration. Unless otherwise noted, the policy, instructions, messages and business requirements in Change Request 4219 apply equally to gynecological oncology.
