1. The permittee shall exercise this privilege subject to the supervision of the Superintendent, and shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations of the area.
2. Damages - The permittee shall pay the United States for any damage resulting from this use which would not reasonably be inherent in the use which the permittee is authorized to make of the land described in this permit.
3. Benefit - Neither Members of, nor Delegates to Congress, or Resident Commissioners shall be admitted to any share or part of this permit or derive, either directly or indirectly, any pecuniary benefit to arise therefrom: Provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to extend to any incorporated company, if the permit be for the benefit of such corporation.
4. Assignment - This permit may not be transferred or assigned without the consent of the Superintendent, in writing.
5. Revocation - This permit may be terminated upon breach of any of the conditions herein or at the discretion of the Superintendent.
6. The permittee is prohibited from giving false information, to do so will be considered a breach of conditions and be grounds for revocation: [RE:36 CFR 2.32(a)(3)].
7. Permittee will comply with applicable public health and sanitation standards and codes.
8. The permittee shall not bring any non-native potted plants, dried flower arrangements or any plant with seeds to be used in any manner.
9. No rocks, vegetation or other natural resources will be moved, stacked, cut or disturbed in any way.
10. All activities, including but not limited to the consumption of alcohol, will be in compliance with state and federal laws.
11. NO items will be left at the site and items may not be stored in the Park. The permittee shall clean up any rubbish generated by the event.
12. Audio devices and music shall not be used in a manner that may disturb other visitors.
13. Entrance fees are required of the permittee and any guests/participants in accordance with Park regulations unless waived.
14. Violation of the terms and/or conditions of the permit may result in the immediate revocation of the permit.
15. ALL instructions by authorized National Park Service personnel will be complied with immediately.
16. Scattering is not permitted at or in Halema'uma'u Crater.
17. Scattering must take place in such a location that the ashes will not be located and identified as

human remains.

18. No memorials, plaques, photos or flowers will be left in the park.

19. The permittee recognizes the sensitivity of this activity and agrees to perform it in a discreet and private manner.
