# EMBASSY AND MABC CO-SPONSOR SME PRESENTATION

On June 11, an expert team from the consulting firm Booz Allen Hamilton discussed the potential of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprise (SME) growth in Oman during a breakfast discussion at the Embassy with members of the Muscat American Business Council (MABC). The team was in Muscat to assist the Ministry of Commerce and Industry's Directorate General of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises (SMEs) in developing strategies for promoting this promising sector in light of the U.S.-Oman Free Trade Agreement (FTA).

Sponsored by the U.S. Department of State's Middle East Partnership Initiative (MEPI), the team is advising Ministry officials on SME international best practices to foster the growth of this important component of Oman's economy. They are working with the Ministry to develop organizational structures to better deliver SME services to clients, with special emphasis placed on women entrepreneurship. The team also is consulting with the Ministry and private sector financial institutions to better deploy capital to qualified SMEs through microfinance, secured transaction frameworks, and loan guarantee programs, among others.

Booz Allen Hamilton is joined by the International Executive Service Corps (IESC), which is charged with providing export management training for SMEs so that they will be better prepared to take advantage of the FTA once implemented. IESC's training modules will address SME competitiveness issues, product selection, and marketing.

Ambassador Gary A. Grappo hailed the team's timely visit in light of Oman's efforts to provide greater economic opportunities for young entrepreneurs. "Oman's economy is poised for further growth with the impending implementation of the U.S.-Oman Free Trade Agreement, and I am very pleased that we were able to sponsor this initiative to strengthen the ability of public and private sector institutions to unlock the great potential of budding Omani entrepreneurs."

The consulting team includes Booz Allen Hamilton associates John Mennel, Veronica Bartolome, and Jennifer Pawlowski, as well as IESC Vice President for Global Operations Tarek Nabhan.

# **Ambassador Grappo Hosts Reception for MABC**

Grappo hosted a reception for approximately 100 members and friends of the Muscat American Business Council (MABC). During the event, the Ambassador praised the MABC as an organization on the move, with membership numbers rising and informative events scheduled on a monthly basis. Over the course of this season, for example, the MABC has sponsored several excellent presentations, including discussions with experts from the U.S. Department of Commerce, U.S. Chamber of Commerce, the Overseas Private

Investment Corporation, the Salalah Free Zone, and Booz Allen Hamilton.

The Ambassador stated that with the impending implementation of the U.S.-Oman Free Trade Agreement (FTA), the Embassy will continue to work closely with the MABC to deliver insightful programming to its members. The backdrop for FTA implementation is especially favorable, given that bilateral trade figures in 2007 surpassed the \$2.1 billion mark, the highest in the 200-plus-year history of the U.S.-Oman relationship. In anticipation of freer trade, U.S. exports to Oman surged over 27% to reach \$1.06 billion in 2007, while Omani exports to the United States rose 14.5% to \$1.04 billion. Bilateral trade between the two nations is off to a good start in 2008, with U.S. exports to Oman up 203% over the first two months, and U.S. imports of Omani products up 472%.


