- MT-36-A-1 SHOT OF THE INTERIOR OF THE ANSELMO ENGINE ROOM LOOKING WEST, SHOWING THE NORDBERG HOIST. BOTH THE HOIST AND THE HEADFRAME WERE MOVED TO THE ANSELMO IN 1936-37 FROM THE BLACK ROCK MINE, WHERE THEY WERE BUILT IN 1911-1912
- MT-36-A-2 WEST END OF THE ANSELMO HOIST SHOWING THE RELATIONSHIP OF THE CLUTCH AND THE BRAKE TO THE HOIST

THE ORE CHUTES AT THE ANSELMO, WHICH RESEMBLE COAL TIPPLES, ARE THE ONLY ONES OF THIS TYPE AT BUTTE

ARE THE DRIES (THE LEFT HALL PREDATES THE STEEL HEADFRAME, THE  
RIGHT HALL WAS BUILT LATER). DIRECTLY BEHIND IS THE CHIPPY  
HOIST, AND TO THE LEFT IS THE MAIN HOIST. THE TANK BETWEEN THE  
CARPENTER'S SHOP AND THE MAIN HOIST IS A COMPRESSED AIR TANK
