Proposal to amend the Fort Sumter General Management Plan; Public meetings announced

The National Park Service will conduct public meetings on October 27, 28, and 29 to present alternatives for the proposed amendment to the Fort Sumter General Management Plan and the associated Environmental Assessment. Public input into this planning process is requested. Alternatives proposed for your consideration include the following:

- I. Alternative A, (no action): This alternative would be to implement the 1998 GMP as written and approved. A no action alternative is required under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The park's current General Management Plan directs that visitors board a ferry to Fort Sumter at one location, the Fort Sumter Visitor Education Center at Liberty Square.
- 2. Alternative B, (preferred alternative): Two ferry departure points are proposed, one at the Fort Sumter Visitor Education Center at Liberty Square and a secondary departure point located in the Mt. Pleasant/East Cooper River area. This alternative meets the objectives associated with the purpose and need for the proposed action and attains the widest range of beneficial uses of the environment, resource protection, visitor safety and enjoyment, and cultural resource protection, without degradation of resources.

A copy of the General Management Plan Amendment and Environmental Assessment will be available on the web at http://www.nps.gov/fosu/gmp/index.htm, and also in print format at Liberty Square, Charles Pinckney National Historic Site, and Fort Moultrie. Limited copies are available and you may call the park at 843 883-3123, ext. 10 to request a copy to be mailed to you. Copies will be sent out as long as they are available.
