Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR) Update #4

During the month of March, the AHAR team conducted conference calls with representatives from AHAR communities to discuss the summary table shells. (These shells provide estimates of the total count of people who used participating and non-participating *emergency shelters or transitional housing* in each jurisdiction during the covered period.) In addition to sharing information about how these shells were constructed and how they are to be completed, the AHAR team obtained useful information about the types of assistance that AHAR communities will need to complete the shells.

As a follow-up to these calls, we are taking several steps. First, we are developing a "super" Excel version of the AHAR table shells that links the four program-household type shells with the summary table shell. A draft of the super Excel spreadsheet is now being tested. We will be mailing a CD with the super Excel spreadsheets and instructions to all AHAR communities during the week of April 11th.

Second, the team is offering one-on-one conference calls with every software solution provider that supports an AHAR community. Our aim is to provide technical support to those providers who are planning to develop "canned" AHAR reports as well as providers that will be advising the communities that they serve on the AHAR table shells. This technical support will augment what the team is already providing directly to the AHAR communities. We also learned during the recent conference calls that there is an inconsistency in the guidance that we previously provided on how to count providers, clients and beds in the AHAR jurisdiction. Our revised guidance is discussed below.

Other items in this update include:

 A comprehensive listing of geocodes, CoC codes, and FIPS codes associated with the AHAR communities (at the end of the update); and

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• An Excel spreadsheet to help communities calculate bed coverage for the local AHAR report (separate file attached to the update).

WHICH PROVIDERS ARE COUNTED AS PART OF THE AHAR JURISDICTION?

Each provider listed in your Housing Activity Chart (see Exhibit 1 of your most recent Continuum of Care SuperNOFA application) has a geocode associated with it. The geocode represents a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) jurisdiction and identifies the geographic location of each provider. Only providers that have a geocode that corresponds with the AHAR jurisdiction should be included in your community's AHAR report.

Several communities have asked where they can locate the correct geocodes, as well as CoC codes and FIPS codes. (Note that the CoC and FIPS code are part of the Program Identification Information data element in the HMIS data standards.) We have assembled the various codes for all the AHAR communities in an exhibit at the end of this update. Most AHAR jurisdictions that are "Urban Counties" will need to use the FIPS codes to exclude some providers that are located within their geographic boundaries but are not in the CDBG jurisdiction. WHICH CLIENTS ARE INCLUDED IN THE LOCAL AHAR REPORT?

Previously, we indicated that clients could be included in the local AHAR report as long as the intake occurred within the AHAR jurisdiction. This guidance was intended primarily to enable programs that provide scattered-site housing to determine which clients to include in the AHAR table shells.

It was recently pointed out to us that this guidance is not consistent with the way providers/beds are counted in the Housing Activity Chart (based on geographic location). Because the Housing Activity Chart is used for reporting coverage for the AHAR, it is possible that some beds would be counted as part of an AHAR community's bed coverage but the clients using these beds would not be part of the AHAR table shells because the intake occurred outside of the jurisdiction.

To address this inconsistency, we have revised the guidance as follows: *AHAR communities* should count all clients who were served by the providers/beds located in the AHAR jurisdiction.

As indicated above, the geographic location of providers/beds is based on each provider's geocode from the Housing Activity Chart. This approach ensures that providers/beds and clients served by these providers are identified and included in the AHAR consistently.

WHICH BEDS ARE INCLUDED IN AN AHAR COMMUNITY'S BED COVERAGE?

With few exceptions, all emergency shelter and transitional housing beds located in the AHAR jurisdiction should be included in an AHAR community's bed coverage calculation. This includes seasonal beds that are available for daily use but are only available for a few months during the year (e.g., winter months). Seasonal beds will be counted in proportion to the number of days they are available during the data collection period (February 1 – April 30, 2005).

Some types of beds should <u>not</u> be included in an AHAR community's bed coverage. These include:

- Overflow beds (e.g., "code blue" beds)
- Voucher beds that function like overflow beds.

Overflow beds are available from time to time, typically as a result of extremely cold weather, a natural disaster, or other conditions that suddenly increase the demand for shelter beds. Unlike seasonal beds, overflow beds are not available for daily use throughout a particular time period.

Voucher beds that function like overflow beds whose availability is sporadic should not be counted for AHAR purposes. However, voucher beds that are available year-round or seasonally should be counted in the bed coverage calculation.

Although overflow and voucher beds that function as overflow beds are not included in an AHAR community's bed coverage calculation, clients who use these beds should be counted in the AHAR report if providers report on the clients using them.

SPREADSHEET FOR CALCULATING BED COVERAGE

Accompanying this update is an Excel spreadsheet that will be a useful tool to help you calculate the bed coverage and number of year-round equivalent beds in the AHAR community. This information is needed to complete the AHAR table shells. The spreadsheet is nearly identical to the Exhibit 1 Housing Activity Chart in your Continuum of Care SuperNOFA Application, with the exception of six columns that were added to the right-hand side of the exhibit. To simplify the use of this spreadsheet you can copy and paste the information from your Housing Activity Chart into this spreadsheet for the projects that are in your AHAR community. Two of the six

columns that were added require you to enter new information. For each project, you will need to enter the number of seasonal beds that report to HMIS and the number of days during the AHAR time period (February 1 through April 30, 2005) that the seasonal beds are available. The other four added columns are automated calculations from the information that was entered.

The spreadsheet will also be valuable to help you document the providers/beds that are included in your AHAR reports (including both HMIS-participating and non-participating providers) and to ensure your bed counts and information on homeless persons using the beds are from the same providers/beds. (*Only providers with the geocode that corresponds to the AHAR jurisdiction should be included in the spreadsheet*.) More detailed information and instructions are provided on the front-end of the attached spreadsheet.

The Islip Town jurisdiction is defined by the U.S. Census Bureau as a county subdivision rather than a place.
- 3 This jurisdiction should use the county subdivision code (3800) as its place code.
