## Report Highlights:

Japanese apple production is forecast to decline 7 percent in 2000 to 862,000 tons. Despite the decline, imports of U.S. apples are expected to remain modest at less than $\mathbf{1 , 0 0 0}$ tons. By contrast, U.S. table grape sales are forecast to jump 5-10 percent, boosted by good quality and competitive pricing.

## 2000 Japanese Apple Crop Expected to Decline Approximately 7 Percent

According to the Ministry of Agriculture (MAFF,) the 2000 Japanese apple crop is expected to decline approximately 7 percent from last year, to 862,500 metric tons. According to Tokyo traders, the short crop will boost wholesale prices 5-10 percent above prices last year.

The taste of apples for the 2000 Japanese crop is reportedly excellent with fairly high Brix levels, according to industry sources. Unlike last year's small sized fruit, there are many medium to large sized fruit this season. The most common sized fruit for this season are size 36 s ( 36 apples per 10 kilogram box), followed by sizes 32, 40 and 28. Currently, an early crop variety, Tsugaru apples are harvested in Nagano prefecture and traded at 200-300 yen ( $\$ 1.88-\$ 2.83$ ) higher than last year, at $3,500-3,700$ yen ( $\$ 33.01-\$ 34.90$ ) for a 10 KG box at Tokyo's Ohta Wholesale Market. The prices will likely stabilize at approximately 3,000 yen ( $\$ 28.30$ ) for a 10 KG box in mid September, when Tsugaru's volume shipment starts. The harvesting of Aomori's Fuji apples has not started until early October. The prices of Fuji apples are expected to go up 5-10 percent from last year, due largely to relatively small crop of Fujis (down 8 percent form last year), according to Tokyo traders. This year's good quality Fujis also encourage higher prices at the market. The wholesale prices of Fujis are expected at 3,200-3,500 yen ( $\$ 30.18-\$ 33.01$ ) for a 10 KG box of medium sized fruit, when Fuji’s peak shipment starts in November.

## Imports of U.S. Apples to Continue Modest in 2001

In March, 2000, U.S. fujis were introduced to Japan and with much enthusiasm by Japanese traders, selling initially at 150 yen ( $\$ 1.41$ ) for a medium sized fruit (size 34). However, sales were not as active as the industry expected and the retailers had to lower prices to clear inventories. The less than expected sales were due partially to widespread marketing of substandard grade apples by Japanese producers. The cosmetically imperfect but tasty Japanese seconds were retailed at 100 yen ( $\$ 0.94$ ) for a medium sized fruit (size 32). In some cases, secondary graded fruit (normally, for processing) were retailing for 50-70 yen (\$0.47-\$0.66) /piece, or 350-400 yen (\$3.30-\$3.77) for a bag of 6-8 apples.

While many Japanese traders report Washington Fujis offer good taste, appearance, and size, improved marketing and better pricing is needed in order to generate significant demand. Traders say a strategy to overcome a poor safety image among Japanese consumers toward U.S. apples is also needed. 1999-2000 Washington apple sales totaled 211 metric tons, valued at less than $\$ 1$ million (CIF.)

## Japan's Apple Juice Imports are Expected to Surge in 2000

Japan's imports of concentrated apple juice are expected to increase significantly in 2000, due to a booming Japanese market of apple juice and a relatively small domestic apple crop in 2000. Further, record-breaking Japan's hot weathers in this summer encouraged Japanese consumption of fruit juices include apple juice. As a recent market trend, apple juice and grapefruit juice, in particular, have gained their market shares in Japan's juice market.

## Japanese Imports of Chinese Apple Juice Jumped Significantly

Imports of Chinese concentrated apple juice (with less than 10 percent sucrose) jumped approximately 61 percent to 12,400 kiloliters in the first half of 2000 compared to the same period last year. China is, by far, the largest supplier of apple juice to the Japanese market, sharing approximately 38 percent of Japan's total imports
of apple juice. China's offer price for apple juice was the lowest among other exporters to the Japanese market, with 132 yen (\$1.24) per liter on a CIF basis for the January - June, 2000. While, import price of U.S. apple juice for the same period was 198 yen ( $\$ 1.86$ ) per liter.

## Western-style Pears Growing Rapidly in Japan

The Japanese production of pears for the 2000 crop is estimated at 414,800 metric tons, roughly unchanged from the year before. "Nashi" production accounts for approximately 93 percent of Japan's total pear production. While accounting for a comparatively small share of total pear production, western-style pears are growing rapidly in Japan, as farmers are responding to better returns on these varieties. The production for the 2000 crop is estimated at 27,200 metric tons. La France is a top variety among others, as its unique flavor and flesh texture are favored by Japanese consumers.

Currently, the importation of U.S. pears are prohibited due to a phytosanitary ban (codling moth.)

## California Table Grapes are Regaining Popularity in the Japanese Market

California Red Globe variety has been receiving a good reputation in its taste and quality among Japanese traders and consumers, according to Tokyo's Ohta Market traders. "In mid 1990s, berries of California table grapes often dropped from the vine before the fruit arrived in Tokyo and the fruit lost its commercial value substantially. Lately, this problem has been significantly reduced with the improved packaging practices by U.S. growers," said an Ohta Market trader. The sales of the 2000 California table grapes are expected to go up 5 - 10 percent, provided the current market condition continues, according to industry sources. Average import price of California grapes was $\$ 1.99$ per kilogram (on a CIF basis) last year. California Red Globe was traded at $3,500-4,000$ yen ( $\$ 33.01-\$ 37.73$ ) for a 18-pound case at Tokyo's wholesale market.

## Chilean Table Grapes Dramatically Increased Its Appearances in the Japanese Market

Japanese imports of Chilean table grapes has jumped 86 percent, to 7,681 metric tons, valued at $\$ 14.2$ million (CIF) in the 2000 season compared to last year. Chile's Red Globe variety, which has gained many Japanese fans, has extremely good quality with high Brix levels. Average import price of Chilean grapes was $\$ 1.84$ per kilogram in the 2000 marketing season, while, the grapes were traded at 2,800-3,000 yen (\$26.41-\$28.30) for a 7.5 KG box in March, 2000 at Tokyo's wholesale market. Chilean table grapes unlikely compete with California grapes in Japan, as the marketing season is totally opposite.

## High Japanese Import Duties on Fresh Apples and Table Grapes

The current Japanese import duty on fresh apples (HS code: 0808.10-000) is 17.0 percent, on a CIF basis. The import duty on fresh table grapes (HS code: 0806.10-000) is 17.0 percent during March 1 to October 31, and 7.8 percent during November 1 to the last day of February, on a CIF basis. These duties will remain the same until further decisions made at the next round of WTO negotiations.
