
Many special things can be found at the seashore. While walking along the beach or on the trails, put a check mark ( ) by the things you see, smell or hear.



drinks plenty of water,




#### Connect the Dots




## Itsy Bitsy Spider




#### Sharks!

Sharks are fish, so they love to swim. Can you color their fins red?




