NORTH PACIFIC GROUNDFISH OBSERVER PROGRAM TRAINING/BRIEFING REQUIREMENTS AND EXPIRATION RULES (last updated: March 1, 2005)

- 1. a) All prior observers must complete a four day briefing before their first deployment in any calendar year;
- b) One day briefings are required prior to subsequent deployments within a calendar year;
- c) Observers who have not been deployed for a period of 18 months (540 days) are required to complete a three week training course; and
- d) Based on performance, prior observers may be required to complete a four-day briefing, a two day briefing, or retake the three week training course.
- 2. If an observer remains undeployed from one to three months (30-90 days) after completion of training, the individual must complete a one day briefing. If the individual is not deployed from three to six months (90-180 days) after training, a four day briefing must be completed. If more than 6 months (180 days) have passed since the completion of training, the individual must retake the full training course.
- 3. If an observer remains undeployed from one to three months (30-90 days) after completion of a four day briefing, the individual must complete a one day briefing. If more than three months (90 days) have passed since the completion of the four day briefing, the individual must retake the full four day briefing.
- 4. If an observer remains undeployed after one month (30 days) from the completion of a two day briefing, the individual must complete a one day briefing.
- 5. If an observer remains undeployed after one month (30 days) from the completion of a one day briefing, the individual must retake the full one day briefing.
