

REGULATION OF RADIO COMMUNICATION.

Mr. ALEXANDER, from the Committee on the Merchant Marine and Fisheries, submitted the following:

REPORT.

[To accompany S. 6412.]

The Committee on the Merchant Marine and Fisheries, to whom was referred Senate bill 6412, an act to regulate radio communication, having considered the same, report it to the House with the recommendation that the bill do pass.

Attention is called to Report No. 698, from the Senate Committee on Commerce, accompanying this bill; also to Report No. 582, made by the Committee on the Merchant Marine and Fisheries, accompanying H. R. 15357. The Senate and House bills are in all material provisions the same, and the committee, in view of the importance of enacting this legislation into law, respectfully urge the speedy passage of the Senate bill.
