STORET/WQX Watershed Summary Tool/New Warehouse Capabilities

- The Watershed Summary tool is available on the web site. Data can be summarized by organization or characteristic type.
- All data from the STORET Warehouse is now delivered in a downloaded tar.gz file.
- We have added the new capability of making metadata information available along with data downloads. To support this, we cannot provide data in a browser window. This new capability also removes the risk of saving an incomplete file while the data is being downloaded into a browser window.
- A tar.gz file type is necessary at this point. We are working to have zip files in the future.
- We are in the process of updating documentation to include instructions on interacting with STORET/WQX warehouse data. We plan to have the files on the web site next week.
- One search site for biological, physical/chemical and habitat results will be an additional feature added to the STORET Warehouse in the future. All data can be downloaded together or separately.
