Dear Messrs. Cope and Hook:

Thank you for your letter dated May 29, 1992 regarding your request for a regulatory determination of soil being stockpiled at the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPTCO) J Yard in Los Angeles, CA. In your letter, you request that EPA review the proposed use of the soil as landfill liner cover at the East Carbon Development Corporation (ECDC) Landfill in East Carbon, Utah and issue a letter stating that the use of soil does not constitute disposal of waste to land. You emphasize that an EPA determination is required to ensure consistency with federal law prior to a determination by the State of California that this use constitutes recycling under California law.

Because the answer to your questions may depend on case-specific factors, this determination should be made by Region IX in San Francisco, CA. Therefore, we are referring your letter to Jeff Zelikson, Director of the Waste Management Division of Region IX. For further information, Mr. Zelikson can be reached at (415) 744-1730.
