

Dorchester. **BLAKE, JAMES, HOUSE**, 735 Columbia Rd., c. 1650. Frame, clapboarding; 2 1/2 stories, rectangular, gabled roof, central chimney, diamond-paned window casements; restored and moved, 1895. One of few remaining New England dwellings built by an immigrant colonial carpenter. Home of John Blake, selectman, General Court deputy, and deacon of his church.
