No significant flooding occurred in the Grand Rapids Hydrologic Service Area (HSA) during the month of October.

October Precipitation

October precipitation totals were well below normal at Grand Rapids, Lansing, and Muskegon, Michigan. Monthly precipitation totals at Grand Rapids, Lansing, and Muskegon, were 0.71, 0.57, and 0.39 of an inch, respectively. Precipitation for the month at these three sites were 2.09 inches below normal at Grand Rapids, 1.72 inches below normal at Lansing, and 2.41 inches below normal at Muskegon, Michigan. For the year, precipitation totals at Grand Rapids were 2.27 inches below normal, 0.83 of an inch below normal at Lansing, and 7.07 inches below normal for Muskegon.

October Temperatures

October was warm across southwest Lower Michigan, with temperatures 2 to 3 degrees above normal. Temperatures for the month of October were above normal at Grand Rapids, Lansing, and Muskegon, averaging 2.8, 3.4, and 3.0 degrees above normal, respectively.

October River Levels

All rivers stayed below flood stage during the month of October. River levels were near to below normal for the entire month of October. The end of the month percentage of normal flow for selected rivers is listed below:
