# Internet Meetings on CLUIN

(TIFSD service, can be used by others) Example: http://cluin.org/meetings/acec (Event-Specific URL provided at event set-up)

How it works: Participants download slides or view live on website while calling into a conference line Features:

- Simple sharing of any file type via download from one website
- > No more inbox overload by emailing large presentations
- No Registration Required, no cost
- Any file type can be posted for download

#### Easiest approach for quick, inexpensive method to share information on a conference call

### Sametime

(EPA-wide service, open to any EPA employee) http://intranet.epa.gov/sametime/sametime\_ servers.htm

or https://epastx.rtp.epa.gov/epacenter.nsf EPA users log-in with their Internet username and password (usually same password used for Webmail & lotus notes)

How it works: Users must log in to schedule an event, participants view materials online through Sametime application in form selected by speakers while listening by phone or computer speakers

#### **Features**

- Optional Advanced Registration with password protection
- $\blacktriangleright$  Live Screen Sharing  $\rightarrow$  watch the speakers annotate materials in real time
- Share control with multiple speakers and participants
- Whiteboard
- Allow multiple parties to share materials and move through materials on other machines
- Voice transmission online available for some regions (with use of computer microphone)
- ➢ FREE to use!
- Poll Participants
- Possible to register non-EPA participants for Sametime account to participate

Best suited for EPA-only training or web-based meetings and collaboration

- Advertise your event on CLU-IN and TechDirect and reach large audiences (150 lines per event)
- Record event to replay later, available in convenient MP3 formats to download to your portable music player
- FREE for participants

Perfect for training the public or large outside groups
