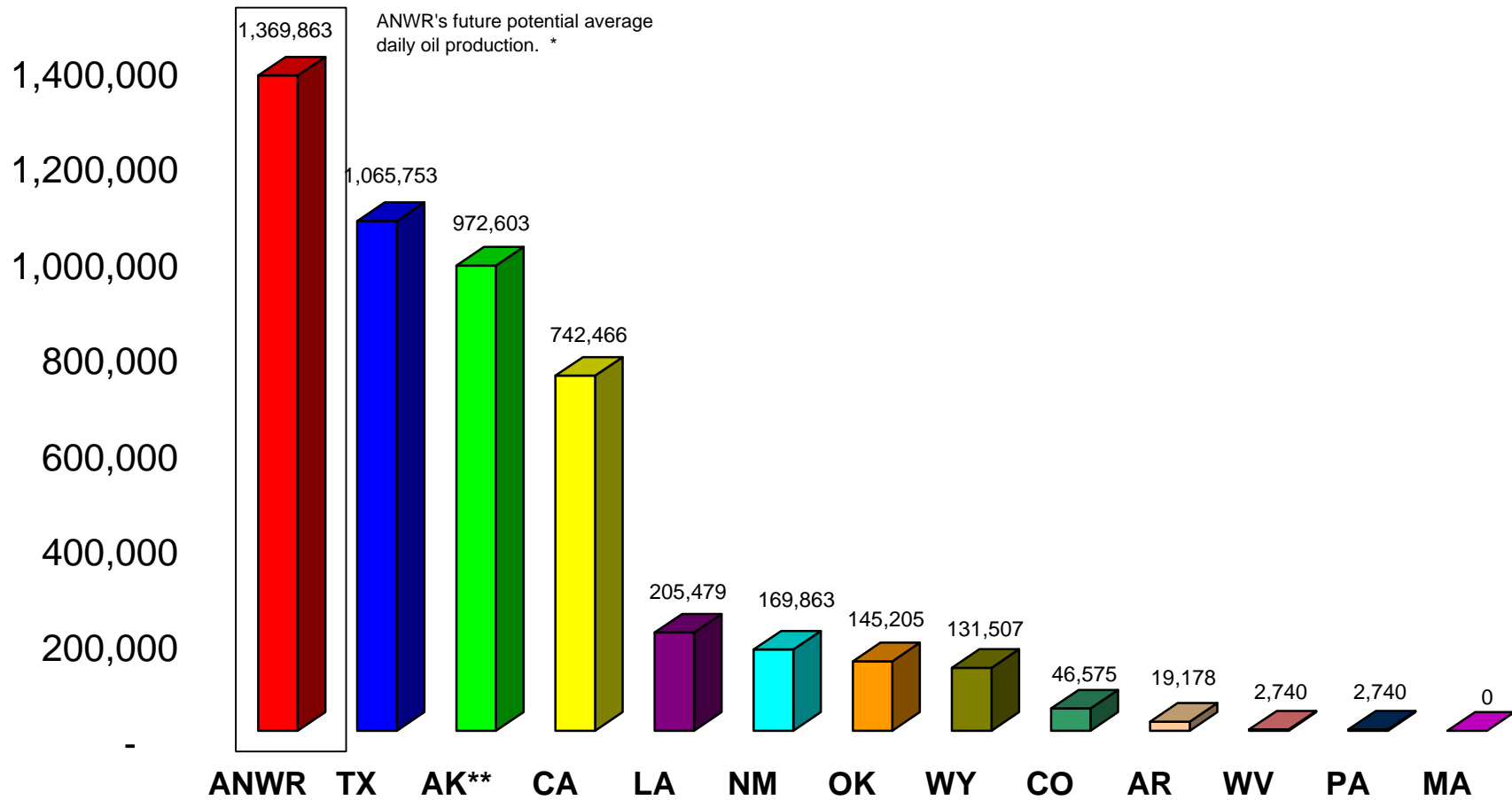


# Average Daily Oil Production

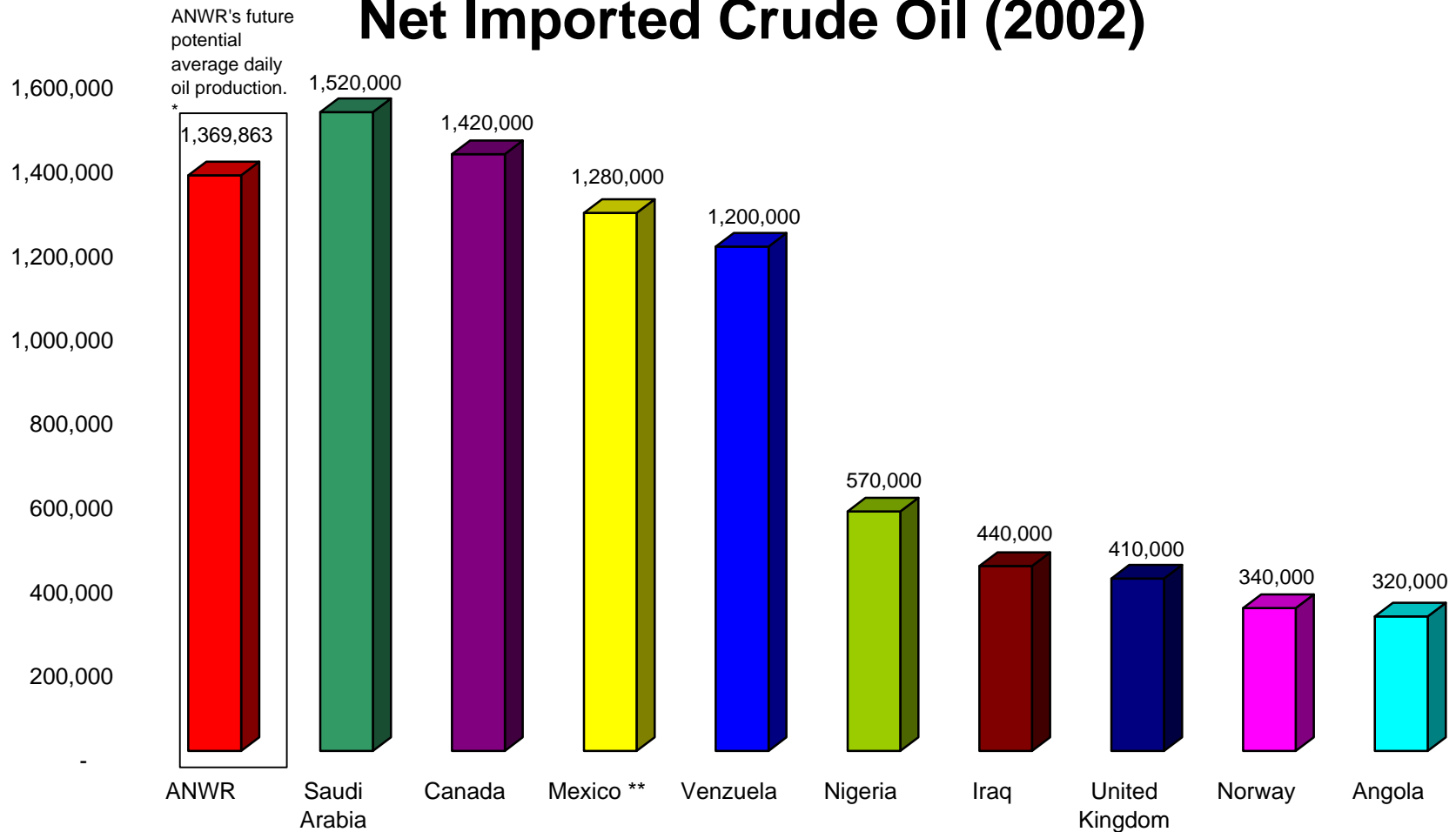

# ANWR vs. Average Daily Net Imported Crude Oil (2002)

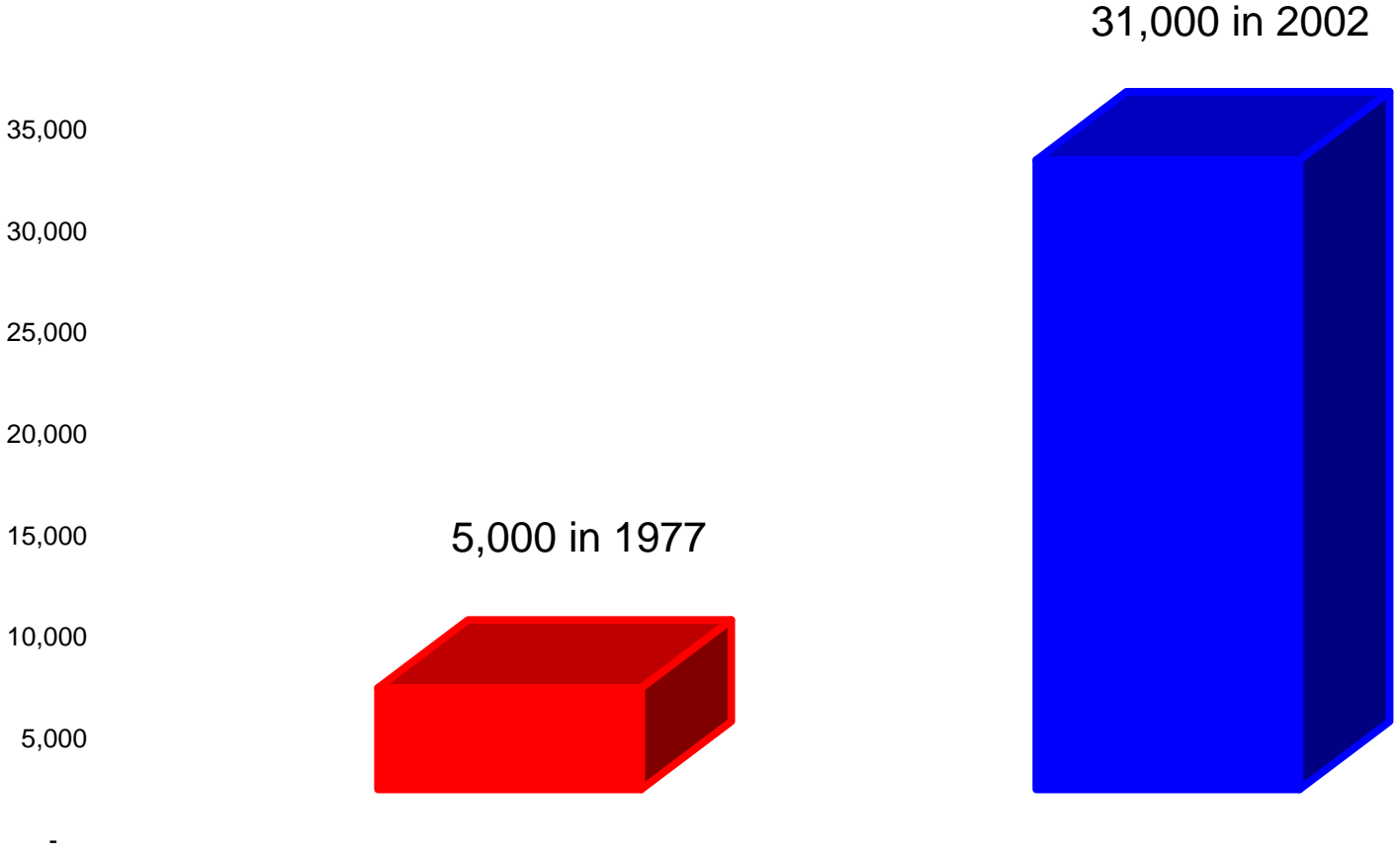
