











#### **Largest Minority Population in the State, 1995 and 2025**




#### **Sub-cultural group:**






## **Acculturation Spectrum**




Rates per 1,000 Live Births, 1995





### **Childhood Immunization Rates:**



#### **Influenza Immunization Rates:**


Persons 65 and Older, 1995


Women 18 and Older in the Past 3 Years, 1995


Deaths per 100,000, 1996



### **AIDS Rates for Children under 13:**


