


World Fresh Potato Production



World Fresh Potato Exports Dominated by Small Players







EU Loses Export Market Share to Other Major Global Players




Key Import Markets Remain Flat, While New Markets Grow

Top World Importers' Shares of Fresh Potatoes by Quantity U.S. Gains Share



U.S. Potato Market



U.S. Potato Production by State


2007 Forecast Up 2 Percent at 20.3 Million MT


Market Utilization of U.S. Potatoes Frozen & Table Stock Account for Half



Average Grower Prices for U.S. Potatoes





U.S. Exports of Potatoes by Group Frozen Share Grows Fastest





U.S. Net Trade Deficit in Fresh Potatoes Expected to Narrow in 2007/08




Exports to Canada Fell Over Last 5 Years, Diverted to Mexico & Other Markets

U.S. Fresh Potato Exports to Other Markets Grew Faster than to Canada and Mexico



EU Became Net Importer in Fresh Potatoes in 2002/03, Imports Rising, While Exports Dropping



United States & Canada Expect Modest Increases in MY 2007/08




World Exports Dominated by Canada, But U.S. Catching Up Fast


U.S. Grabs Export Market Share from Canada Canada's Export Share of Frozen Potato Products Shrank, While the U.S. Share Grew


U.S. Frozen Potato Products Exports Grow, Canada's Remain Flat

U.S. Exports Forecast Up 10-Percent in 2007/08, While Canada Expects Only 4-Percent Growth





World Demand for Frozen Potato Imports Surged by 30 Percent Over Last 7 Years U.S. Continues to Dominate Imports





U.S. Market for Frozen Potato Products Modest Market Growth Expected for MY 2007/08



Exports Forecast to Grow 50 Percent From 2003/04, Imports Expected to Remain Flat





U.S. Frozen Potato Products Exports Rise in Quantity & Value







EU's Frozen Potato Products Exports


Exports to the Middle East & Russia Account for Most of the Growth


EU's Frozen Potato Products Imports


Japan's Frozen Potato Products Imports Imports from U.S. & China Rise

Australian Frozen Potato Trade Deficit Widens


Australia Became Net Importer in 2002/03

U.S. Net Trade in Dehydrated Potato Products



U.S. Exports of Dehydrated Potato Products by Group




U.S. Potato Chip Exports
