13A. Exhibit A, Origin and Breeding History of the Variety

- 1. FANCY RED was derived from the radish breeding line <u>C4</u>—which was released by Paul H. Williams, from the Department of Plant Pathology, University of Wisconsin.
- 2. C4 was segregating for disease resistance, top size, maturity, root size, color and shape. Also most of the roots did not have the desired crispiness.
- 3. Individual plant selection were made from <u>C4</u>. These individual plants were selected for the following characteristics.
 - a. Field resistance to black-root (<u>Aphanomyces raphani</u>).
 root-scurf (<u>Rhizoctonia solani</u>) and high resistance
 (greenhouse inoculation) to Fusarium wilt (<u>Fusarium oxysporum f.SP Conglutinans race 2</u>).
 - b. Medium top size (comparable to Cherry Belle)
 - c. Globe-shaped, medium-sized roots, that are bright red in color and exhibit good degree of crispiness, as well as resistance to splitting.
- 4. After 3-4 generations of repeated single plant selections the characters described in item Number 3 were stabilized in individual plants.
- 5. Individual plants described in item 4 were mass increased in an isolated plot in the field.
- 6. Step 5 was followed by three generations of mass selection and mass seed increase.
- 7. Performance trials in New York, Florida and California convinced us that one of our sub lines, A/1956, is highly stable, uniform and disease resistant.
- 8. A/1956 was named FANCY RED, and will be released as a novel variety, being distinct, uniform and stable.

13B. Exhibit B, Novelty Statement

FANCY RED has several novel characteristics which are not present in any one single commercial red globe radish variety.

FANCY RED combines resistance to fusarium wilt (<u>Fusarium oxysporum</u> f.SP. <u>Conglutinans</u> race 2), and high field tolerances to black-root (<u>Aphanomyces raphani</u>) and root scurf (<u>Rhizoctonia solani</u>).

In addition to disease resistance, FANCY RED is adapted to a wide range of soil types and climatic conditions. The roots have high degree of crispiness and are resistant to splitting.

13B. Exhibit B. Novelty Statement.

"Fancy Red" most closely resembles "Red Prince". However, "Fancy Red" is resistant to black-root caused by Aphanomyces raphani and to root scurf, caused by Rhizoctonia solani, whereas "Red Prince" is susceptible to black-root and root-scurf.

13D. Exhibit D, Additional Description of the Variety.

FANCY RED has uniform, medium-sized tops, that are comparable in size to the tops of Cherry Belle. The roots are medium-sized (comparable to Scarlet Knight), and bright red in color. They are uniform globe-shaped, and exhibit good degree of crispiness. The roots also showed resistance to splitting under sub-optimal growing conditions.

FANCY RED reaches the marketable stage in around 25 days. This, however, could vary a little depending on weather and soil conditions. Although FANCY RED performs best under moderate temperatures, it did rather well under higher temperatures. Adequate soil moisture and fertility are necessary for good yield.

FANCY RED combines a number of features which make it suitable for bunching and packaging.

ASSIGNMENT


