Dear Mr. Robertson,

We have reviewed the final revision to the Washington regulations 246-220, 246-221, 246-232, 246-233, 246-235, 246-240 of the Washington Administrative Code, received by our office on October 28, 2008. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 61, 150 and the requirements of the four amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Terry Frazee on December 18, 2008.

As a result of our review, we have five comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that if these regulations are revised, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure [SA-200](#).

We request that when you revise your regulations to address our comments, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in FSME Procedure [SA-201](#), "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the location of any changes made by Washington, in response to our comments, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) (see letter FSME 06-94 dated October 6, 2006 for further information).

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Washington regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
