These necessary rules will be immediately effective and administered by EPA in all States pursuant to RCRA Section 3006(g). For example, use of a Class I modification to add waste codes and/or narrative descriptions of treatment residues to RCRA permits may be necessary in appropriate situations to effectively implement the treatment requirements and prohibitions of the HSWA land disposal restrictions program. Other examples involve a change in interim status needed to comply with an EPA-issued Section 3008(h) corrective action order to comply with the minimum technology requirements of HSWA Section 3004(b).
